## Directions using one color of thread:

Round 1: Using 2 shuttles wound CTM.
Shuttle 1: R 5-5-6. [MP. SR 6/5-5]x5. J in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{P}$ of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{R}$. Do not cut threads.
Round 2: Using same threads from previous round.
Shuttle 2: Ch 10.
Shuttle 1: R 6-6.
Shuttle 2: Ch 12.
Shuttle 1: R 6-6.
Shuttle 2: Ch 10. J in space between SR's of previous round, and $j$ the first $R$ of each repeat to the second R of the previous repeat.
Repeat around motif. Cut and finish ends.
Round 3: Using 2 shuttles wound CTM.
Shuttle 1: J to any pair of R's from previous round. Ch 18.

Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 18. J in P's of next 2 rings simultaneously. Repeat around motif. Cut and finish ends. Block.


Directions using two colors of thread:
Round 1: Using 2 shuttles.
[SR 5-5/6. MP]x6. J in base of $1^{\text {st }}$ SR. Do not cut threads.
Round 2: Using same threads from previous round.
Shuttle 1: Ch 10.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 12.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 10. J in space between SR's of previous round. SLT.
*Shuttle 2: Ch 9. (Note: The J and the SLT together take up the same space as one DS, so only 9 DS are needed here.)
Shuttle 1: R 6-6.
Shuttle 2: Ch 12.
Shuttle 1: R 6-6.
Shuttle 2: Ch 10. J in space between next two SR's. SLT.
Shuttle 1: Ch 9.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 12.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 10. J in space between next two
 SR's. SLT.
Repeat from * around motif. Cut and finish ends.
Round 3: Using 2 shuttles.
Shuttle 1: J in P's of $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{R}$ on first chain of previous round and $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{R}$ on next chain simultaneously. (Even if your shuttle has a hook, a regular crochet hook may be helpful to draw the loop through both P's.) Ch 18.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 18. J in P's of next two R's simultaneously. SLT.
*Shuttle 2: Ch 17. (Note: The J and SLT together take up the same space as one DS, so only 17 DS are needed here.)
Shuttle 1: R 6-6.
Shuttle 2: Ch 18. J in P's of next two R's simultaneously. SLT.
Shuttle 1: Ch 17.
Shuttle 2: R 6-6.
Shuttle 1: Ch 18. J in P's of next two R's simultaneously. SLT.
Repeat from * around motif. Cut and finish ends. Block.
