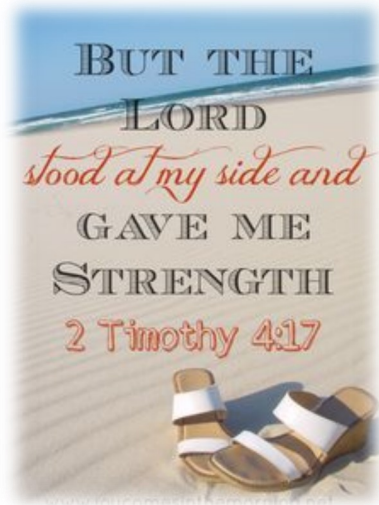
The New Testament Reading
