




24. REMOVE BACK WINDOW UPPER OUTSIDE MOULDING




5. REMOVE UPPER TOOL BOX PANEL SUB-ASSEMBLY

a. Remove the upper tool box panel sub-assembly as shown in the illustration.




6. REMOVE TOOL CASE

a. Detach the 2 claws and remove the tool case.

- b. Detach the 5 claws and remove the back door inside handle bezel.




8. REMOVE BACK DOOR TRIM PANEL ASSEMBLY


a. Detach the claw and remove the cover.




ii. Detach the 15 clips and remove the back door trim panel assembly.


c. Detach the 8 claws and remove the spare wheel cover.

a. Remove the 4 screws and No. 2 spare wheel cover.




14. REMOVE REAR SPOILER COVER RH


15. REMOVE REAR SPOILER SUB-ASSEMBLY

a. Remove the nut and rear wiper arm.




17. REMOVE REAR WIPER MOTOR ASSEMBLY




b. Remove the 3 bolts.

c. Detach the 2 guides and remove the rear wiper motor.



- a. Using a clip remover, detach the clamp.
- b. Remove the 3 bolts.
- c. Using a clip remover, detach the 2 clips and remove the No. 1 back window wiper motor bracket.




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19. REMOVE BACK WINDOW OUTSIDE MOULDING

a. Using a knife, cut off the 2 outside mouldings as shown in the illustration.

NOTICE:

- Do not damage the vehicle body with the knife.
- If the vehicle body is damaged, repair the damaged portion by applying an anti-rust coating after removing the back window glass assembly.



b. Remove the remaining outside moulding from the back door glass.

20. REMOVE BACK DOOR GLASS

a. Apply protective tape to the outer surface of the vehicle body to prevent scratches.

NOTICE:

When separating the back window glass from the vehicle, be careful not to damage the vehicle paint or interior/exterior ornaments.

- b. Disconnect the connectors.
- c. From the interior, insert a piano wire between the vehicle body and glass as shown in the illustration.

- d. Tie objects that can serve as handles (for example, wooden blocks) to both wire ends.
- e. Cut off the adhesive by pulling the piano wire around the back window glass.


NOTICE:


- When separating the glass from the vehicle, be careful not to damage the vehicle paint or interior/exterior ornaments.
- Leave as much adhesive on the vehicle body as possible when removing the back window glass.
- f. Place matchmarks over the glass and vehicle body at the locations indicated in the illustration.


HINT:

Matchmarks do not need to be placed if the glass is not going to be reused.




23. REMOVE BACK DOOR GLASS ADHESIVE DAM

a. Using a scraper, remove the 2 dams.

NOTICE:

- Be careful not to damage the back door glass.
- Be sure to replace the 2 dams with new ones.



24. REMOVE BACK WINDOW UPPER OUTSIDE MOULDING

a. Using a scraper, remove the outside moulding LH and RH.

NOTICE:

- Be careful not to damage the back door glass.
- Be sure to replace the mouldings with new ones.
