The finished snowflake measures about 4 inches ( 10 cm ) when made in size 20 thread, about 3.25 inches ( 8.2 cm ) when made in size 50 .

Note: DDS are unflipped stitches of first half, second half, made on the ring thread with Sh2, forming a picot covered with stitches. The ring that is bearing the daisy picots is tatted as usual with Sh1.

Center: Wind Sh2 with 3 yards, Sh 1 with 1 yard. This can be either a continuous thread or a different color on each shuttle if you wish. Note: the picots on the floating rings should be very small.

R 1ds,
*\{5 DDS, FR 3ds - 2ds - 3ds, 5 DDS\}, 2ds, repeat from * until you have 12 daisy picots, then end with 1ds, close ring.

$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ Round: Wind 5 yards onto one shuttle, and leave attached to the ball.
First Small ring: R2-2-2-2-2-2. RW.
Ch $4+4+4-4$ (join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ picot of FR of previous round, then join to $1^{\text {st }}$ picot of next FR). RW.

First Trefoil: R 8+6-5-3 (join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ last picot of small ring).
R 3+6-6-6-3 (join to last picot of previous ring).
R 3+5-6-8 (join to last picot of previous ring). RW.
Ch $4+4+4+4$ (join to picot of previous chain, then join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ picot of FR, then join to $1^{\text {st }}$ picot of next $F R$ ). RW.
**Next Small ring: R 2-2+2-2-2-2 (join to the last picot of the 3rd ring of the previous trefoil). RW.
Ch $4+4+4-4$ (join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ picot of $F R$ of previous round, then join to $1^{\text {st }}$ picot of next FR). RW.
Trefoil: R 8 $+6-5-3$ (join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ last picot of small ring).
R 3+6-6-6-3 (join to last picot of previous ring).
R 3+5-6-8 (join to last picot of previous ring). RW.
Ch $4+4+4+4$ (join to picot of previous chain, then join to $2^{\text {nd }}$ picot of $F R$, then join to $1^{\text {st }}$ picot of next $F R$ ). RW.
Continue from ** until you have tatted all the way around the center, but when you reach the last picot of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ring of the final trefoil, join to the $2^{\text {nd }}$ picot of the first small ring (a folded join will be needed for this). Then tat last chain.

$3^{\text {rd }}$ Round: Wind 4 yards onto each shuttle, a different color on each. Note: a JK is a small ring made of repeated half stitches (either $1^{\text {st }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$ half, but consistently the same).
U to open picot of $3^{\text {rd }}$ ring of any trefoil.
***Ch 2-2-2, JK 10, 2-2-2. L to open picot of ${ }^{\text {st }}$ ring of next trefoil. RW. Switch shuttles. Ch 7, join to nearest picot of center ring of trefoil, 7-2. RW.

Ring with daisy picots: Note: to change the color of the DDS, just flip the stitches. R 2, \{5 DDS - 5 DDS\}, 2, \{5 DDS - 5 DDS \}, 2, \{5 DDS - 5 DDS\}, 2, close ring. RW. SLT. Ch $2+7+7$ (join to picot of previous chain, next join to nearest picot of center ring of trefoil). LJ with Sh2. RW. Switch shuttles.
Repeat from ${ }^{* * *}$ around the snowflake, tie, hide and cut ends, and block to finish.
