## Joyful Bell


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## Supplies:

- 2 shuttles
- Thread of your choice (the finished bell measures about 1 and 1/4 inches (3.2cm) long in size 20 DMC Cordonnet Special)
- A small crochet hook is helpful for joining picots


## Techniques used:

- Split rings
- Rings floating from chains
- Join on $2^{\text {nd }}$ half of split ring


## Abbreviations:

Ch chain
j join

+ join
LJ lock join, or shuttle join
R ring
RW reverse work
Sh shuttle
SR split ring
SS switch shuttles
- picot
-- long picot
/ separates number of stitches on each side of a split ring,

Note: all joining picots are small. The decorative picots can be longer as desired.

R 8-6-8. Do not RW, SS. Ch 15.
RW. SR 3+3/4-4.
*Ch 4. Using Sh 2, R 3+5-3. Ch 4. Using Sh 2, R 3+3-3--3-3-3.
Repeat from * 2 more times.
Ch 4. Using Sh 2, R 3+5-3.
Ch 4. RW. SR $3+3 / 4+4$. (Note: $2^{\text {nd }} j$ is on $2^{\text {nd }}$ half of SR, so be sure that the core thread still slides)
Ch 15. LJ to beginning. SR 8/8. Thread ends may be used for hanging as an ornament.
