



# ower Bookmarks

## Easy, beginner level project!

All the joins in this pattern are lock joins, also known as **shuttle joins**. The drawings below show how to make this kind of join, which locks the thread so that the double stitches stop sliding at that point.





#### Pattern:

Leave long tails when starting. R 2-2-2-2. RW. \*Ch 6-6, shuttle join to next p of R. Repeat from \* around.

Cut thread, leaving long tails.

#### **Abbreviations:**

R ring Ch chain - or p picot RW reverse work



**Tip:** When you are ready to start the first chain, just hold the ball thread in position -you don't need to tie a knot.



The first double stitch of the chain.

### Finishing tips:

Form a simple, attractive tail with the remaining threads. Tie the last 2 ends by taking the core thread (the one that matches the color of the ring) through the 1st ring, bringing the chain thread around to tie the 1st half of a square knot. Then gather all the ends together and tie one big overhand knot, snugging it up tightly to the base of the bookmark. Trim ends as desired.
