Age to be taken as at 1st January 2009

14. Preliminary Championships will be included in all Qualifying Championships provided that there are at least 6 competitors. To compete in a Preliminary Championship, competitors must not have been placed in a top three position in an Open Championship or first place in a Preliminary Championship within the last 12 months.

n.b. A Preliminary Championship is a competition which has been judged by a panel of at least three adjudicators and must have included a light and heavy round.
15. Changing facilities will be provided and must be used. **NO CHANGING IN THE HALL WILL BE ALLOWED.**
16. The use of hair spray will only be permitted in designated changing areas. **NO HAIR SPRAY TO BE USED IN COMPETITION HALLS.**
17. Toe blocks or any other footwork danced “en-pointe”, whether stationary or moving, is not permitted for those dancers born after **31st December 1997.**
18. THE DRESS CODE IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN COIMISIUN RULING WILL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED. i.e. for the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the feis scantily dressed.
19. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability of capturing a dancer’s image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. mobile phones, still camera, video/camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition.
20. In respect to competitors, please switch off all mobile phones or electronic games in the competition hall.
21. Any form of coaching during a competitor’s performance is strictly prohibited.
22. Aisles and walkways must be kept clear at all times.
23. **All other rules as laid out in the syllabus for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2010 will be complied with.**
24. The Regional Council reserves the right to remove any individual from the competition hall where it believes the above rules have been contravened.
25. **SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE BUILDING.**

RULES

1. Entries will only be accepted directly from teachers registered with **AN COIMISIÚN**.
2. All entries must be made on the enclosed official entry form, which must be fully completed and signed by the teacher. The dancer's **FULL FIRST NAME** and **SURNAME** must be entered in **BLOCK CAPITALS**.
3. The Regional Council may modify or cancel any arrangements detailed in this syllabus as is deemed necessary, subject to the approval of AN COIMISIÚN.
4. Adjudicators decisions are final.
5. Complaints (written) and accompanied with a £10.00 fee to the Feis Secretary within an hour of the incident. The fee will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
6. Competitors must be present when their competition is called and fully obey all directions from Feis Stewards and Hall Keeper, or they may lose their right to dance.
7. Competitors must dance in the order determined by the Stage Steward or may lose their right to dance.
8. Competitors **must** use the designated areas to practise and **must not** practise in competition halls, corridors, side stage etc. This rule will be strictly enforced.
9. Any dancer found causing damage to floor surfaces outwith the areas designated as official practise areas will be personally liable for any necessary repairs.
10. All trophies are perpetual challenge trophies and must be returned at the request of the Regional Council.
11. Tempos for Solo Championships will be the same as those stipulated for the World Championships.

13. All competitors must be in full costumes, including appropriate footwear when receiving awards, otherwise such awards may be forfeited.
