Musical Penquins for Concept Development

Target Vocabulary: first, last, 2nd, 3rd, 4th before, after, last and middle, right, left, and turn over.

Materials needed for this activity: CD player, CD of children's music, Cards with the words 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, before, after, last, middle, center, in front, behind. A set of cards and small stuff animal are needed for each table.

Instructions: A figurine or small stuffed toy is placed in the center of a table. The cards are distributed printed side down around the table. The 1st, middle, before, after and last need to be used. The other cards are used according to the number of children you have. There should be a card for each child. Divide the children in groups and instruct them to stand behind the cards. Decide if they will go to the left or right. Tell them to circle the table in the appropriate direction until the music stops. When the music stops they will stand behind one of the cards at the table. They are instructed to turn the cards over and an adult helps read the cards. The middle child takes the figurine from the center of the table and starts forming a line. The children then decide their positions from their cards. The children with the before and after place themselves before and after the bear accordingly. Once the line is formed they return to stand around the table. The figurine is placed in the center of the table and placed face down again. The game can be continued for another round of music.


