Our soul's reality is infinite. Therefore we must learn to love everybody, and everything.

How can we do so? Many people are so distinctly unlovable! I was in an airport only the other day, watching hordes of airplane passengers as they walked by, filled with ego, hostile toward their own families, thinking only of themselves and their own desires and ambitions, clogged with the fat of an excess of desires and attachments.

And I said to a friend, "How easy it is to accept what Krishna says in the Bhagavad Gita: 'Out of a thousand, one seeks Me'!" If I had spoken about God to almost any one of them, he might have called for the police!

And yet, the germ of God-consciousness is in all of us, for God manifested us all from His Bliss. How can this be?

I had a revealing dream several years ago in Florence, Italy. In the dream I was standing on a busy street corner. Passing by was the usual motley crowd of humanity: businessmen bustling with ambition; Mafiosi types determined to "get theirs" at any cost whatever to others; housewives, engrossed completely in home and babies; and good people also, concerned for the well-being of others. And I realized that there was one thing that united every one of us: the desire for happiness.

Some hoped to find happiness by seizing it from others. Some hoped to find it by wresting it from life through hard work and the accumulation of a useless pile of possessions. Others thought to find it by gathering happiness comfortably around them. Others thought to find it, and indeed had found it to some degree, by sharing it with others. But all of them had, basically, the same goal in life: to be happy.

Indeed, how could things be otherwise? All of us are products of God's bliss. How could anyone not want—each according to his own understanding—to reclaim that bliss?

And this fact, I realized, gave me a reason to love everyone on earth. Often, when I have been feeling particularly blissful, I look around me at people, whether friends or strangers, and feel deep love for each and every one of them. I often smile at complete strangers. Better still, I often find that complete strangers smile at me, sometimes even before I smile at them!

We are united by the simple fact that all of us want the same thing. The sad thing only is that most people don't yet know that is what they want.

We should try to expand our egos, and not merely to obliterate them. This we can accomplish by trying to feel ourselves in others. We should identify with their griefs—not to the extent of grieving with them, however. We can help them best if we sympathetically share with them our happiness. The Master Key to the laws of the universe is love.

Swami Sri Yukteswar wrote in his book, The Holy Science, of the effect of love on the human body: "When love, the heavenly gift of Nature, appears in the heart, it removes all causes of excitation from the system and cools it down to a perfectly normal state; and, invigorating the vital powers, expels all foreign matters — the germs of diseases — by natural ways (perspiration and so forth). It thereby makes man perfectly healthy in body and mind, and enables him to understand properly the guidance of Nature."



Sri Yukteswar explained further the effects of love on human understanding: "When this love becomes developed in man, it makes him able to understand the real position of his own Self as well as of others surrounding him."

Paramhansa Yogananda, Sri Yukteswar's chief disciple, taught that the only way truly to understand others is by feeling deep compassion for them in one's heart. Psychoanalysis is usually intellectual, and therefore provides only superficial insight into human nature. Deep insights are possible only with empathic love. That is why, when Paramhansa Yogananda was once asked, "What can take your place after you leave this world?" he replied with the sweetest smile, "When I am gone, only love can take my place."

Love, that is to say, not only for God, but for God in others, in mankind, in all beings: this was his true meaning. As we contemplate the rays of Dwapara Yuga, it should be clear that love alone will help us fully to absorb their beneficial energies.

In this way there are many dangers in knowing the future by ordinary persons and that is why ancient seers kept this science secret, and taught them only to those who had controlled and overcome the effects of good and bad things in life. I know fully well that no modern man can achieve a receptive state of mind as he has filled it with unnecessary feelings and emotions. ## **Choosing sadhana**

In our daily lives choice is imminent at almost every second. How we make decisions, perform actions and express ourselves using words ultimately defines our character. In life people are ordinarily judged by their character. Such a judgement call usually requires an in-depth analysis of a person's weaknesses, strengths, achievements, and failures. Inevitably, one forms an instant opinion of a person based on their character.

There is no doubt that character is indeed important, but spirituality goes even beyond character. Spirituality deals with perception and understanding. ## Role of spirituality in development

FLORA TECKIE

Development efforts have so far been too materialistic in their approach. The current concept of development, based mainly on a materialistic approach, has not been able to solve the problems for which it was intended. It has neither been capable of leading humanity to the tranquillity and prosperity which it seeks. The spiritual nature of humankind and the role of religion in influencing our attitudes and the spirit in which we carry out everything, including our development projects, have been forgotten or ignored. At one extreme, deprivation and despair afflict vast numbers of the world's peoples, whilst, at the other very few have access to abundant wealth.

While searching for alternative approaches, development practitioners are increasingly realizing that new efforts will only succeed when spiritual values and their enforcement are made an essential part in the development process "No matter how far the material world advances," the Baha'i Writings state, "it cannot establish the happiness of mankind. Only when material and spiritual civilization are linked and coordinated will happiness be assured". And also that, "successful development efforts require, above all, a spirit of cooperation and collaboration among the participants in the development process. The absence of such a spirit of common endeavour up to the present time -- within local communities and nations as well as between countries -- constitutes in our view the main reason for the limited success ... and the persistence of gross economic inequalities. ... The required higher level of cooperation can only be motivated by a sincere appreciation for the unity of all human beings. Only on such a basis can prejudices related to nation, race, religion, sex, and other prejudices that hinder determined and equitable development activities be eradicated". Besides the importance of cooperation at every level, it is essential that all members of a community have input into decisions that affect the entire group. Through dialogue at grassroots level the experiences and aspirations of the people can be incorporated in shaping action.

According to the Universal House of Justice (the governing council of the Bahá'í international community), in a 1985 statement entitled 'the Promise of World Peace': "The inordinate disparity between rich and poor, a source of acute suffering, keeps the world in a state of instability, virtually on the brink of war. Few societies have dealt effectively with this situation. The solution calls for the combined application of spiritual, moral and practical approaches. A fresh look at the problem is required, entailing consultation with experts from a wide spectrum of disciplines, ... and involving the people directly affected in the decisions that must urgently be made." The creation of a peaceful and just society, in which everyone is able to meet his/her basic human needs; the people of diverse background cooperate and live in harmony, will require a significant reorientation of individual and collective goals and transformation in attitudes and behaviours. We have to set aside trends based on past thinking and ask fundamental questions and reconsider the basis of development theory, both in terms of science and in terms of religion.

Religious and spiritual values should be viewed not as separate from "real world concerns," but as vital sources of knowledge and motivation, as source of values, insights, and energy without which social cohesion and collective action to overcome our current disparities are difficult, if not impossible, to achieve.

The Bahá'í Faith is the youngest of the world's independent religions. Its founder, Bahá'u'lláh (1817-1892), is regarded by Bahá'ís as the most recent in the line of Messengers of God that stretches back beyond recorded time and that includes Abraham, Moses, Buddha, Krishna, Zoroaster, Christ and Muhammad.

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## **Understanding Yoga Part IV**

SWAMI SHANKARANANDA MAHARAJI

During *pratyahara* we become self-observant, whereas in *dharana*, attention is focussed on a single point. Extended periods of concentration lead naturally to meditation.

#### 7. **Dhynam** (Concentration/meditation)

Uninterrupted meditation is called *dhyanam*. Concentration (*dharana*) leads to the state of meditation. Where *dharana* is one-pointed attention, *dhyanam* is the state of being deeply aware without focus. The goal of meditation is heightened awareness and oneness with the universe. At this stage, the mind is calm, and in stillness produces little or no thoughts at all. How can we know the difference between concentration and meditation? If there is awareness of distraction, you are only concentrating and not meditating. The calm achieved in meditation affects all aspects of life—whether we're having a challenging day at work, stuck in traffic, or just shopping for groceries. The stamina required to reach this stage involves many years of disciplined practice. If it seems to be taking a long time to reach this stage, we should not be discouraged or give up. While this task may seem difficult or impossible, remember that yoga is a process. Even though we may not attain the ideal state of consciousness immediately, we will benefit by daily progress.

#### 8. Samadhi (Blissful state)

The ultimate goal of the eightfold path of yoga is *samadhi*, or absolute bliss. This super consciousness is attained when we realise that we are one with the universe. Those who have attained *samadhi* are considered to be enlightened. Paramhansa Yoganananda called *samadhi* the state of God-union. Patanjali describes this final stage as a state of ecstasy where the meditator merges with his or her point of focus and totally transcends the Self. The meditator realises a profound connection to the Divine, and interconnectedness with all living things. With this realization comes the "*peace that passeth all understanding*" (Holy Bible, Phil. 4:7), the experience of bliss and being 'at one' with the Universe. What Patanjali described as the completion of the yogic path is, deep down, that which every human being aspires to: peace. We should also consider the fact that the ultimate stage of yoga (that is, enlightenment) can neither be bought nor possessed. It is to be experienced, the price of which is the continual devotion of the spiritual seeker.

The eight steps are interconnected. The first five steps — yama, niyama, asana, pranayama, and pratyahara — are the preliminaries of yoga and build the foundation for spiritual life. They are concerned with the body and the brain. The last three steps (which are not possible to attain without first mastering the first five) are associated with reconditioning the mind and helping the yogi attain enlightenment – full realisation of oneness with the Divine.

## Creating a work of art

Conceiving a child and raising it to feel loved is the most significant action parents can attain. A loved child becomes not only a creative, inspiring being but one who helps all living things to survive and thrive. Think of your child as a young artist who has come to you to learn how to paint or sculpt. As a teacher you would show patience and guide and instruct the child so they can create a work of art. You would not throw out their painting or pottery but show them how to rework it and create a true work of art. Well you have the clay, the paint and the blank canvas to work with; your child.

As a surgeon I listened to eighty five year old parents complain about their kid and I had to laugh remembering they were talking about a kid, who was in his sixties. We can constantly be critical of our children by using phrases like, "There's something wrong with you." Or we can let them know they are loved even when we don't like what they are doing.

I know from working with all age groups that when you ask eighty or ninety year olds whether their parents loved them close to ninety percent answer yes; but when you ask high school students the same question the figures are reversed. When for homework you ask students to write a note about why they should commit suicide and why they are loveable the suicide notes are three to five pages long and the love notes one page. I am not trying to depress all the parents reading this. I have lived the experience with our five children so I know wounds can be healed and that if we are truly educated about the parenting experience our children will be the beneficiaries. Licenses are needed for just about every significant activity or occupation except parenting. So when the birthing classes finish start parenting classes and learn from those who have preceded you and lived the experience.

Why is it your children's children are called grand and their children become great grand children? The answer is that as we grow and mature and learn what is truly important in life we see the children as grand and great. So if you do not have time to read this entire article all I ask of you is to act as if you are a loving grand parent towards your children. I was born an ugly duckling, who my parents hid in a covered carriage. I survived because I had a grandmother who, to quote my mother, "Poured oil over your body and pushed everything back where it belonged many times a day." I didn't have to find my own beauty, as the ugly duckling did, because I had a grandmother. Studies show the benefits of massage in newborns by their rapid weight gain. So touch and massage your children and watch them grow and develop in response to your loving touch. One teenager I know said she was staying at her grandmother's house and there were no full size mirrors for her to look in before she went off to high school. When she complained to her grandmother her grandmother said, "Come over here and look into my eyes and you'll see how beautiful you are." There are many ways to touch your child.

We must remember the opposite of love is indifference. So the child who feels unloved and drives you nuts gets your attention. While the angel often feels unloved because no one pays attention to him. As one of our children said, "I don't get twenty per cent of your time." I explained his brother drove us nuts and got forty per cent. I admire the fact that he felt comfortable confronting his father with those statistics. When siblings are born one or five years apart there is little rivalry. So apologize, as I have, to our kids and help them become a family. Our children learned that love and appropriate anger can exist together. Make magic and do things as a family every week. It can be eating out, going skating, visiting a museum,



whatever; just make it an activity that allows you to interact and not sit staring at a TV set or a movie screen. When you do the latter have a session in which you all discuss your reaction to what you saw and learn from each other.

Various states are currently debating passing laws to ban spanking until age four and not allowing smoking in cars with children under the age of six, while a religious cult in another state wants a law passed to allow whipping of children. I can see the fourth birthday becoming spanking day to make up for what parents weren't allowed to do until that day. It is absurd. What we need is a law which says you must love your children. I know smokers who smoke outdoors to protect their pets but do not think about their children's lungs. Love is the answer. As Emmet Fox wrote, "There is no difficulty that enough love will not conquer; It makes no difference how deeply seated may be the trouble; A sufficient realization of love will dissolve it all." A young woman I know whose parents are alcoholics started saying to them every morning, "I love you." They never answered her. After doing this for three months she ran out of the house one morning late for school. Her parents were in the street yelling, "You forgot something." "What did I forget?" "You didn't say I love you." Their healing began.

Yes, love is a weapon and I prefer to kill with kindness and torment with tenderness.

When we do this our natural tendencies towards aggression are utilized in creative ways through work, sports, games and hobbies and not through destructive behavior. A child's brain wave pattern up to the age of six is like that of a hypnotized individual. So your messages can stay with them for a lifetime. If they are mottoes to die by, and the child does not make a conscious effort to eliminate and abandon them, it does lead to their illness and early death.

A study of Harvard students showed that of those who felt loved by their parents, while attending college, only one fourth had suffered an illness by midlife while almost one hundred percent of those who didn't feel loved had suffered a major illness by midlife. The addictions and self destructive behavior are not an accident. To quote a woman who said her mother always belittled her efforts and only dressed her in dark clothes, "My mother's words were eating away at me and maybe gave me cancer." The cancer motivated her to be born again and redirect her life; reparent herself, find self love and buy a red dress. So curses can became blessings as castles can be built out of the mud.

Centuries ago Maimonides wrote, "If people would take as good care of themselves as they do their animals they would suffer fewer illnesses." So get some pets and treat your children as you do your beloved pets with love, affection, trust, respect, consistency, discipline, exercise and a reverence for life. Those bits of advice actually come from veterinarians. So when in doubt WWLD; just ask yourself What Would Lassie Do?

If your children have any questions just remember love is my answer. My Mom's answers were, "Do what will make you happy." "Troubles are God's redirections and something good will come of this." And my Dad's, "Material things are to make life easier and when you are happy you are a success."

## **Learning the Spiritual Laws**

Whenever I look at a child, I see a little adult. Mighty oaks from acorns grow. There's no impulse to talk down to children once you realize they are Souls returned from an older time and place. They need today's leg of their spiritual journey, too, the same as you and me.
