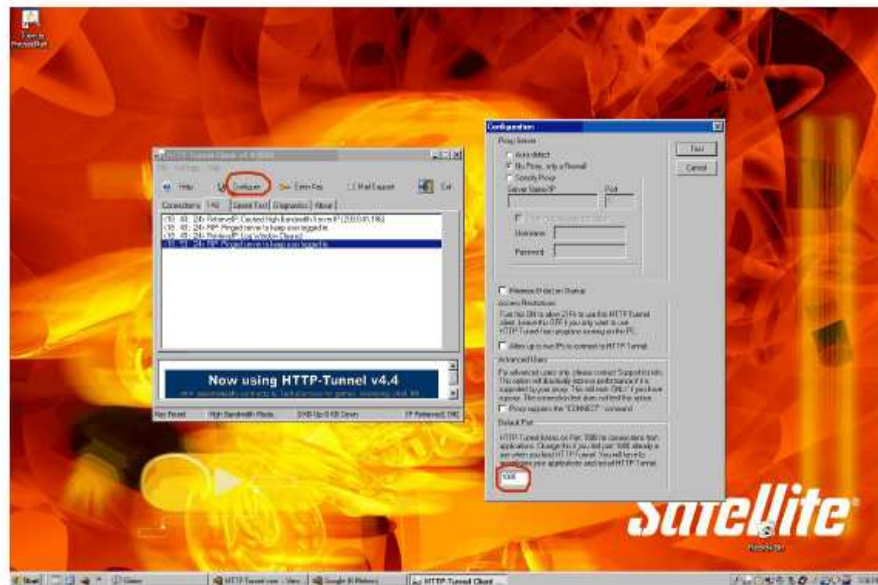


This guide will show you how to configure VZOchat to use Http-Tunnel.

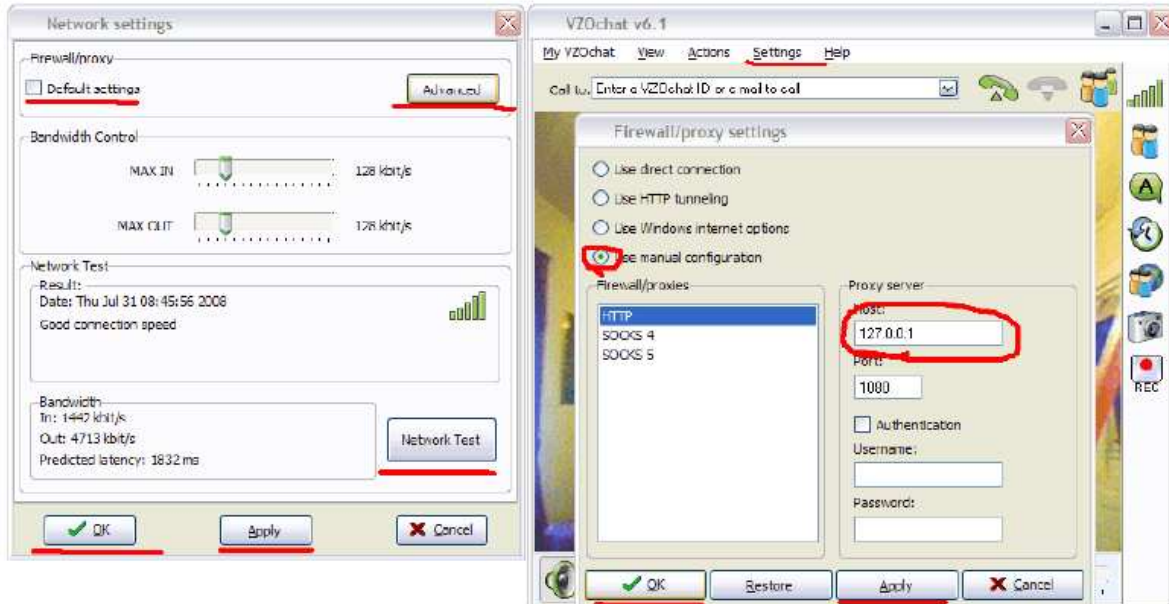
Once you have Http-Tunnel installed, run the application, The main window will appear, choose the configure option. There you will be presented with three (3) options.

1. You can Select Auto detect if you want Http-Tunnel to detect your settings.
2. No Proxy, only a firewall if this is appropriate.
3. Specify Proxy, Here you will enter the IP address and Port number of the proxy that you use.

Complete 1 of the 3 options, then click test, the client will bind to port 1080 and localhost by default and connect to the tunnel servers if your settings are correct.



Open VZO Chat. Select '>' Settings '. A pull down menu will appear. Choose '>' Network settings '. The ' Network settings ' window will appear. Remove the check mark from '>' Default settings '. Click 'the' Advanced ' radio button. The '>' Firewall/proxy settings ' window will appear. Put a dot in '>' Use manual configuration ' In the '>' Firewall/proxies ' section select 1 of the 3 protocols: HTTP, SOCK4 or SOCKS5. Then in the ' Proxy server ' section: In ' Host: ' enter: 127.0.0.1 then in ' Port: ' enter 1080 Then click Apply and Ok. Then click the ' Network Test ' radio button. If the configuration is correct then '>' Click ' Apply and Ok.



1 thing I have noticed about this program. *This file: shellreg.vsp in the VZOchat folder is flagged as Win32Dialer. By Some Anti-virus and Malware programs. This may be a false positive. After some testing I determined I did not need the file. In the end I used a file shredder using the 3 times overwrite DoD method to render it impotent. There were advisories that the file was needed. I ignored those and eliminated it anyway. *This file: shellreg.vsp: The parent folder in Program files is: Visicron/VZOChat. I have not notice any problems after doing so.
