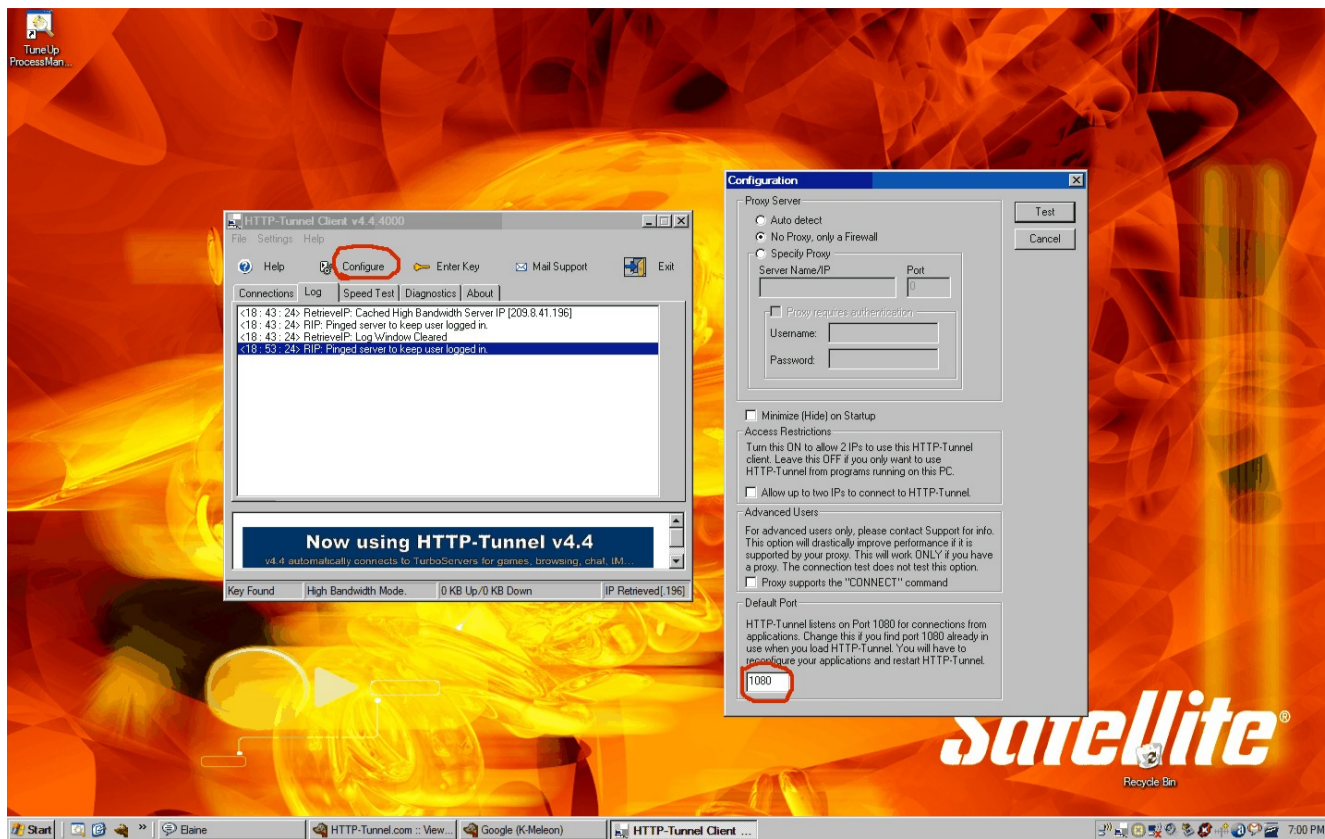


This guide will show you how to configure LastChaos to use Http-Tunnel.

Once you have Http-Tunnel installed, run the application. The main window will appear, choose the configure option. There you will be presented with three (3) options.

1. You can Select Auto detect if you want Http-Tunnel to detect your settings.
2. No Proxy, only a firewall if this is appropriate.
3. Specify Proxy, Here you will enter the IP address and Port number of the proxy that you use.

Complete 1 of the 3 options, then click test, the client will bind to port 1080 and localhost by default and connect to the tunnel servers if your settings are correct.



LastChaos is not natively configurable to use a proxy (HTTP Tunnel) like Internet Explorer is. So you will need, what some refer to as, a Socksifying Agents. Socksifying Agents can provide limited support for applications not natively configurable to use a proxy.

2 of the most popular commercial ones are ProxyCap and Proxifier. Each come with a 30 day free trial and run about \$30. A good free 1 you may want to try is Hummingbird. In this guide I will be using ProxyCap.

Refer to the screen-shots below to configure the proxy and the Tunneling Rule Properties. You need to create a rule for each of the 2 files shown.
