Forrestal Arrives in Time to Bid Hewitt Farewell

STOCKHOLM, Sweden, July 17—Six units of Admiral H. Kent Hewitt's European Fleet left here this morning for Antwerp after a six-day stop during which the crews were fêted at private parties and official receptions.

Before sailing Admiral Hewitt received Admiral Ekstrand, commander in chief of the Swedish Navy, who presented three volumes of the "History of the Swedish Navy" bound in special leather. Secretary of the Navy James V. Forrestal arrived here from Rome just in time to say farewell to Admiral Hewitt. Mr. Forrestal is staying two days and will have talks with the Defense Minister.
