Ask God which order to do the 3 parts.

#### (1) Follow Jesus (45 minutes)

- 1. Have each person share for 5 minutes what they applied from this week's reading (including their Stars). Could be something to remember and live by or an action to do. James 1:22
- 2. Have each person share how many days this week they read BOTH the Bible and the study notes.

### (2) Fishing and Disciple-making (25 minutes)

- 1. Have each person share about any fishing they did this week. Includes both witnessing and meaningful contacts/acts of service to non-Christians on their fishing list. Matt 4:19, Luke 5:10
- 2. Pray for each other's top 5 on their Fish list.
- 3. Spend 10 minutes to start memorizing the next verse on the "John Road" gospel presentation. (John 14:2b-3, 8:31-32, 8:24b, 8:51b, 12:25-26, 12:24)
- 4. If they are leading their own A-Team discuss discipling principles.

# (3) How Are You (30 minutes)

- 1. Have each person share:
  - 1. What they are thankful for
  - 2. What they are concerned about (want prayer for).
- 2. Pray in one accord. Only pray for one person at a time. After a period of silence then pray for another.

# Long-Term Goals (discussed as part of Loving Accountability)

- 1. Give and share the John Road (if possible) Life Application Study Bible Gospel of John to at least two people a month. Therefore:
  - 1. Develop multiple non-Christian friendships.
  - 2. Learn to share with people you meet in the course of the day ('Divine Appointments')
- 2. Start discussing the Gospel of John with a non-Christian.
- 3. Start an A-Team with Christian(s).
