

Tips On How To Prepare For The Transport Of A Car For Transport

You've made the decision to ship your vehicle to a new location. You have found an auto transporter. Now you need to get the vehicle ready to be shipped. Wash Your Vehicle

Wash your vehicle's exterior first. The driver will complete an inspection of the vehicle's condition upon arrival to pick up your vehicle. This report details the condition of your vehicle, and any damages that might be present.

Clean vehicles aid both of you to complete the condition report. You'll be aware of any scratches, dents paint chips or other damages.

Take photos of your vehicle

The time is right to take pictures after your car has been cleaned. Be sure to take photos that are of good quality and are not too old! Don't take photos of areas that are damaged. You can also capture general shots of the vehicle from various angles. To ensure your safety in the unlikely possibility of damage happening during transport, it is best to never have enough photos.

Take a photograph of the Odometer

This tip is to ensure your security and safety. People will often inquire, "How can I tell if the driver won't take my car for joy rides?" Although we have not had this experience, we do recognize the anxiety. After all, you are giving the keys to one of your most valuable assets over to a complete stranger. It is possible to take a picture of the odometer in case you are nervous.

Clean the interior of your Car

Car trailers are huge and are able to bounce around quite a bit when driving which can cause loose objects inside your car to move around. Remove any objects that aren't securely attached to your car's interior including phone chargers, GPS devices and portable DVD players air fresheners, pen, spare change, and even car chargers. If there's a chance for anything inside your vehicle to bounce or move around, causing harm to the inside of your vehicle, or to the items themselves, remove them. They can be removed to lessen the possibility of them being stolen or lost during transportation.

Attach or remove the accessories

To avoid damage to your vehicle or the accessories and prevent damage to them, you must remove them if they can be removed. Accessories such as racks for luggage and skis are accepted. If your antenna is able to be removed, you should take it off and place it in the trunk of your car. You can fold the side view mirrors, if they are foldable.

Examine the Battery, Radiator and Tires

Check for antifreeze in the radiator, and that the battery is charged and secure.

Check for Fluid Leaks

You should check for leaks of fluid prior to you hand over your vehicle to the driver. If there is a serious leak, the driver could refuse to take the vehicle. If you have only minor leaks that can't be repaired before delivery, inform the driver know!

Treatment of Mechanical and Engine Problems

Is your car in good working order? Check for engine and other mechanical issues, and if you're in a position to, then have an expert tune it prior to picking your vehicle to be transported.

Alarms can be disabled

The last thing your driver wants to deal with is a car with an alarm going off that he can't easily access (or an alarm he doesn't know how to turn off once he gets to the vehicle).

Deactivate or remove Toll Tags

No matter whether your vehicle is operating on toll roads or being tow by a trailer you will most likely be charged the fee. Avoid any unnecessary headaches and expense by deactivating or remove your toll tags.

Keep your keys ready

It's a bit difficult for the driver to take your vehicle off and on the trailer without a set of keys! A vehicle that is older might require a set of keys, for example, keys for ignition, door lock key, and possibly keys for the glove compartment.

Have Insurance on Your Vehicle

You can transport your vehicle when your vehicle is insured. It is highly recommended you have insurance in force when your vehicle is being transported.
