Summary Minutes of Canton Liberal Club Committee Meeting Thursday 8th July 2021

Meeting Started: 19:00 Length: 1 hour 10 minutes.

The Chairman opened the meeting and the Secretary set out the agenda.

The Secretary stated that we could not increase our labour costs any further if we were to pay our way. It was noted that service has always been an issue – we can only use labour justified by the takings. Over 70 people turning up at once (like Saturday after trip) would have created delay whatever staff and system we had in place and having to use table service makes it worse.

The Chairman closed the meeting.

The Chairman then opened an investigatory meeting into a member's actions some time ago.

The evidence was heard in the absence of the member involved, that member having failed on several occasions to respond to requests to attend.

After deliberation it was decided unanimously that there was a case to answer.
