

- 6 ACROSS "A \_\_\_\_\_ went out to sow his seed..." **LUKE 8:5**
- 4 ACROSS "...some fell by the \_\_\_\_\_; and it was trampled down, and the birds of the air devoured it." **LUKE 8:5**
- 5 DOWN "Some fell on \_\_\_\_\_; and as soon as it sprang up, it withered away because it lacked moisture." **LUKE 8:6**
- 2 ACROSS "And some fell among \_\_\_\_\_, and the thorns sprang up with it and choked it." **LUKE 8:7**
- 1 DOWN "But others fell on \_\_\_\_\_ ground, sprang up, and yielded a crop a hundredfold..." **LUKE 8:8**
- 4 DOWN "The seed is the \_\_\_\_\_ of God." **LUKE 8:11**
- 3 DOWN Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they believe and be \_\_\_\_\_. **LUKE 8:12**
- 9 DOWN "The ones on the rock receive the Word with joy, but \_\_\_\_\_ away." **LUKE 8:13**
- 7 ACROSS "The ones who fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are \_\_\_\_\_ with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity." **LUKE 8:14**
- 9 ACROSS "The ones who fell on good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it bear \_\_\_\_\_ with patience." **LUKE 8:15**
