Important Notes on Creating Additional Language Heritage Honor Roll Stories and Landing Pages

- 1. After the first legacy story is created, click on "Create a legacy story in an additional language" on your "Welcome Back" page to begin working on a second story. Members can create as many new stories in a foreign language as they desire. However, because both storytellers are using the same language database, a foreign language cannot be used more than one time, except for the languages on the list that have been modified.
- 2. To assist you in creating your honoree's legacy story in an additional language, we have provided you a copy of the English-language version to use as a guide. To create this version of your story, delete the English-language text and replace it with the new language text. If a field is not changed, the data from the English version will remain the same as the English-language version.
- 3. Since Legacy Partner landing pages can only accept one story from each member, delete the 6-digit number of the landing page you selected for your English-language-version story from this new "additional language" template. Your English language version of the story will not be affected.
- 4. To create a second story in English, select the top link under the list of languages. The template that appears will have the text of the first story. Simply delete the old text and add the new text for the second story.
- 5. After each additional story is created and published, a new link will appear on your "Welcome Back" page, so you can modify the story at anytime.
- 6. To help you gain more exposure for your story, you can hyperlink all language-versions of your story to each other, or to the story of another member on our site. <u>Click here</u> to learn how this can easily be done.

The creation process for "Create a Legacy story in an additional language," (see page 5) and "Create a Legacy Partner landing page in an additional language" (see page 7) is the same, and they both use the same language database. (1)

At no additional cost, you can create your honoree's legacy story or a Legacy Partner's landing page in as man√additional languages as you desire. However, each additional language cannot be used more than one time, ∮xcept for those languages on the list that have been modified. To help you create either a story or a landing page, we heve provided you with a copy of the Englishlanguage version to use as a guide. To create this new version, delete the English-language text and replace it with the new language text. Text and image fields that are not modified will remain the same as in the English-language version.

Similarly, you can post your Heritage Honor Roll stories to as many Legacy Partner landing pages as you desire, but each Legacy Partner landing page cannot accept more than one s**f**ory from each member. Therefore, you must delete the 6-digit number of the landing page you selected for your Engl<mark>i</mark>ch-language-version story from the new "additional language" template. This will not affect the English language veysion being posted to that Legacy Partner landing page.

To help you gain more exposure for your story, you can hyper<mark>⊮</mark>nk all language-versions of your story to each other, or to the story of another member on our site.

You can create your new story in two ways:

- If you can change your keyboard settings to the desired language, delete the English-language text and replace it with the new language text.
- If you cannot change your keyboard settings prepare your honoree's story in the desired language offline and cut and paste it into the template to replace the English-language text

If you do not find the additional language you desi<mark>/</mark>e listed below, please <u>contact us</u> and put the word "Additional Language" in the subject line.

Note: Many words and expressions do not hav∳ the same meaning in all languages. To ensure your honoree's legacy story or Legacy Partner landing page in the new language carries the same meaning as the English-language version, we advise that you do not rely on an automatic translation app.



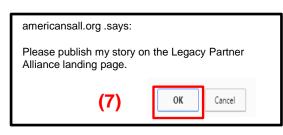

Remove or Reinstate a Legacy Story

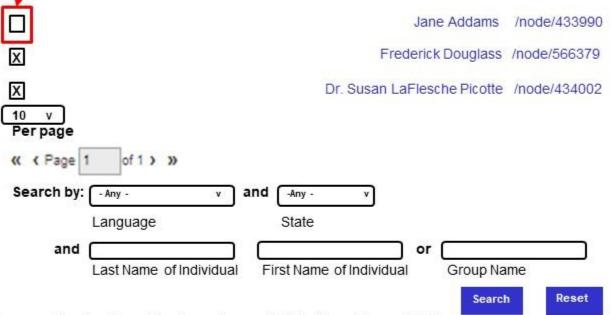
Americans All members can select as many Legacy Partners landing pages as they choose to host their Heritage Honor Roll story. These are organizations with which they or their honorees are affiliated. However, Legacy Partners maintain the right to accept or remove a legacy story.

By clicking on the "Edit my Legacy Partner landing page" link under the "Actions" tab on your "Welcome Back" page, you will be taken to a page to remove or reinstate a legacy story as well as update your Legacy Partner landing page.

If your landing page is open when a legacy story is added, the page must be refreshed for the story to appear. Otherwise, it will automatically appear when you log in again.

To remove a story, uncheck the box in front of the honoree's name and click on the "Publish" button. The honor 's name will remain on the page (the box will be unchecked) and the story will not be visible to the public on your landing page. A notice of removal will be automatically sent to the creator of the story.

If the story was removed in error, check on the box in front of the honoree's name and then click on the "Pu∦ish" button. A notice of reinstatement will automatically be sent to the creator of the story.
