# Read 1 Cor 1:17-2:5

## **Suggested Discussion Starters**

Paul was writing to a church that was messed up and full of messed up people.

- 1. What does Paul say was the emphasis of his ministry and why did he make it so?
- 2. Paul says that he was sent to preach the gospel: if you had the opportunity, how would you explain the gospel to someone who had little or no knowledge of it?
- 3. Can you give an example of how the preaching of the gospel has affected or influenced your life?
- 4. In v20 Paul states some alternatives to the gospel that the Corinthians might have been looking for. What were they? What form do you think they took? Why were they appealing?
- 5. What alternatives to the gospel do Christians look for today?
- 6. Why does the church seem to have such a hard time sticking to its message?
