## Robert Furey, Sr.

This morning Robert Furey, Sr., father of ex-Street Commissioner Furey, died, in the 79th year of his age, at his residence, 149 Prospect place. The deceased was a native of Ireland, and came to Brooklyn to reside fifty-two years ago. He was a vegetable dealer in Fulton Market, New York—his son James now carrying on the business. With the exception of about eight years, the deceased had always lived in the Fifth Ward. The funeral will take place on Thursday at St. Joseph's R. C. Church, in Pacific street, and the interment will be in the Cemetery of the Holy Cross. Mr. Fitzgerald's wife, whom he married in this country, survives him at the age of 74.
