He likes all of them except carrots.</p> <p>Which vegetable does John give to his neighbor?</p>
<p>My little sister is riding her bike behind me. My mother is riding her bike in front of me.</p> <p>Where am I?</p>	<p>When there is a snowstorm, we can listen to either the radio or the TV for school closures.</p> <p>How many do we need to turn on?</p>	<p>The class will work on their math assignment until the bell rings.</p> <p>When will they stop?</p>
