## The Mission

This activity uses vocabulary that is used in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade reading and social sciences curriculum

To start a round, each player is given a mission card. The card gives a list of items needed to accomplish a mission. Once the five items are collected the player takes the mission accomplished card and a round is completed. The cards are reshuffled and a new mission card is handed out. Whoever has the most mission accomplished cards at the end can be declared the winner.

Players are dealt 5 cards for each round. Cards that are left are placed in a stack. One person becomes a dealer. The dealer takes one card from the stack. He can choose to keep it or pass it to the left. If the card is kept the dealer choose a card from his hand and passes it to the left. Each player in turn takes the card handed to them and decides what they want to passes on to the left. The last player to get a card puts one into a discard pile. If the draw pile runs out, the discard pile is shuffled and becomes a new draw pile. This continues until someone collects the 5 items they need on their mission card. The person to the left of the dealer then becomes the new dealer.


