Six-Week Mission:


Week 1: Investigating

Playing with your favourite pet, choosing an animal to research.

Looking at the way animals/pets move, the things they eat, what they collect.

Making a place in your room, which is the animal zone! Decorate it.

Curator's Tip: be careful not to do anything unhygienic or dangerous ;).



Week 2: Animal Character

Playing at getting in role as the animal with its moves and behaviour.

Looking at the conditions your animal lives in and the things they do.

Making a costume and props for your animal character.

Curator's Tip: you can exaggerate your animal or make it like a human.

Week 3: 'It can SPEAK!'

Playing with a way to make your animal character communicate.

Looking at cartoons with animal characters online.

Making a diary of your animal's day or a script with a friend.

Curator's Tip: keep your diaries or scripts secret for now.

Week 4: Animal Drama

Playing in role making a scene with friends for an animal play.

Looking to use an object that your animal collects – twigs, food – as part of the story.

Making an amazing performance by rehearsing and perfecting it.

Curator's Tip: You could make notes and take photos to show your work.

Week 5: The Show

Set up a performance friends and neighbours. It could be in the garden, inside or even on the street itself if it's safe.

It could be in your bedroom, in the animal zone. Find a way to make it exciting and dramatic for the guests. You could make tickets and a programme.

Curator's Tip: You could make a painting or drawing showing what happened at the performance



Week 6: Caboodle It!

Make a Caboodle of your project and characters including descriptions.

Caboodler's Tip: You need at least five photos to publish your pictures with short descriptions on Caboodle.org.uk

Museum Mission: Go to a museum that contains information about the natural world. You could also go to animal performance. If you have permission take photographs of what you find and include at least three cool facts for Caboodle.
