Six-Week Mission:

Week 1: Drawings

Playing with different kinds of pens, pencils and paint making lines.

Looking online and in books to find examples of bones.

Making a large piece of bone art on a big piece of paper.

Curator's Tip: If you have used charcoal on your picture 'fix' it with spray.



Playing with different shaped bone cutouts that you have made.

Looking online to see what you can find for 'skeleton puppets'.

Making your own spooky skeleton puppet theatre out of an old box.

Curator's Tip: If you hang your puppet over the edge of the theatre you'll be able to get some great photos.

Week 3: Halloween

Playing in role as a spooky Halloween ghoul.

Looking for info about the history of Halloween online.

Making a Halloween display on your bedroom wall.

Curator's Tip: Take care not to damage your wall when sticking things up.

Week 4: Dinosaurs

Playing in role as a scientist exploring the garden.

Looking using your imagination to pretend where dinosaur bones may be buried.

Making a drawing of the imagined discoveries using images online to help.

Curator's Tip: Including the dinosaur's names on the sheets will help anyone looking at them later.

Week 5: Teeth

Playing with various art materials and a mirror.

Looking at the various shapes of your teeth and the patterns in your mouth. Also look at animals teeth online.

Making a piece of art entitled 'The Teeth'.

Curator's Tip: If you take a photo of your art piece you can create a digital display.



Week 6: Caboodle it!

Make a Caboodle of all your 'Bones' research, artwork and discoveries including descriptions.

Caboodler's Tip: You need at least five photos to publish your pictures with short descriptions on Caboodle.org.uk

Museum Mission: Go to a museum that contains bones. You could also go to a nature park. If you have permission take photographs of what you find and include at least three cool facts for Caboodle.
