Thank you for your interest in our preschool. This brochure briefly outlines our policies so that you will gain a better understanding of our program. A more detailed parent's handbook will be given to you once your child has enrolled. You are welcome to visit our facilities. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have. Please call our office to schedule a visit. We look forward to having your child in our school.

PURPOSE

Our purpose is to lovingly provide the opportunity for each child to develop to his/her fullest ability.

PHILOSOPHY OF LEARNING

In a caring and positive atmosphere, we create a warm and happy place for preschoolers to learn. As we bridge the gap from home to school, we guide children to a continued good self-image while building social skills in a school setting.

Sensory, motor, perceptual, and language skills are introduced through materials and activities, which are both child-centered and teacher-directed. Activities emphasize the

process rather than the product, fostering a sense of accomplishment and pride.

LICENSING

Nu'uanu Baptist Church Preschool is licensed by the State of Hawaii and conforms to the Rules Governing Group Day Care Centers. We are inspected annually, are licensed to accept up to 49 children, and are insured.

ELIGIBILITY

All children enrolling in Nu'uanu Baptist Church Preschool must be three years old by December 31 of the year for which they are enrolling.

*Children must be completely toilet trained.

REGISTRATION

A child is considered registered when the school receives the registration form and registration fee. If classes are filled, you will be notified that you are on a waiting list. Registration is year round and is on a first-comefirst-served basis.

SCHOOL HOURS

Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m.-11:30 a.m. (half day)

Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. (full day)

*Children should arrive at school no later than 8:15 a.m.

FEES

Registration fee: \$50.00 Paper goods fee: \$50.00 T-shirt fee: \$7.50

Monthly tuition:

Half Day (7-11:30 a.m.) \$525 Full Day (7-5:30 p.m.) \$595

- *Registration fee is non-refundable.
- *Tuition is due the 15th of each month for the following month. Checks are to be made payable to Nu`uanu Baptist Church Preschool.
- *Tuition will not be refunded for temporary absences of illnesses or family vactions.
- *Active Nu`uanu Baptist Church members will be exempt from paying the registration fee.
- *Two weeks' notice must be given in writing before dropping out of school; otherwise two weeks' tuition will be due.
- *Children not picked up on time will be assessed a late fee.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The Student's Health Record (Form 14, from your doctor) must be submitted before the first day of school. The physical exam must include all immunizations required by the Department of Health. For the protection of all, children with colds or any sign of a contagious disease will not be permitted in the classroom.

THINGS TO BRING BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- *Registration form and \$50 fee
- *Student's Health Record
- *Birth certificate (the original will be returned to you) This must be the one issued by the STATE and not the one the hospital gives you.
- *Light blanket with child's name on it.
- *Change of clothing with child's name on each item. Place all items in a plastic bag: underwear (2), t-shirt, shorts.
- *\$50-paper goods fee
- *Tuition: Half day -\$525

Full day-\$595

- *Pink Emergency card
- *\$7.50 for preschool t-shirt
- *Developmental Health History form
- *Lunch Bunch form (if buying lunch)
