IGOR S. MAKAROV

Autobiography

I, Igor Stepanovich Makarov, was born in Moscow (Russia) on August 18, 1935. I graduated from the Moscow Institute of Communications in 1958 and started my carrier as an engineer at the Research Department of the same institute. From 1960 through 1963, I studied at the postgraduate course of that institute, leaving it in 1964 with the scientific degree of Candidate of Science in Communications (approximately PhD in Technology). For about 20 years, I had worked at the Research Institute of Radio (Moscow), including 12 years as Senior Researcher. I have got 12 works published in scientific journals and one invention. In 1992 I immigrated in Israel, traveled much across Europe, lived two years in Canada and now, since August 2007, have been living in Israel. I was married twice, now divorced.

Late in the 60s, I started my independent research in Systems Theory, which gradually involved Theoretical Physics and Philosophy thus providing me with a new method of research in physics. Four parts of the research were published in the Indian Journal of Theoretical Physics (Calcutta, 1996-2005). In July 2007, living in Britain, I printed privately in small edition the whole research as a book, titled "A Theory of Ether, Particles and Atoms", and distributed it to libraries and academies of some Western countries; in 2008 I registered the book at the Copyright Office. In March 2009 I printed its second edition later subjected to some minor corrections; in November 2009 I visited Amsterdam and mailed dozens of copies of the book to universities, libraries and scientific centers the world over.

My above research initiates the reform of modern physics and, owing to its new method, paves the way to the reform of modern science in general including humanities, which in our time of science is of vital importance for the destiny of civilization. To proceed with the reform of science, in 2010 I set up my website, *The Reform Science Center*, www.reformscience.org, aimed at creating a full-fledged organization to that end. However, the extremely hostile environment I am living in at present, a hostel created and controlled thoroughly by Russian agents in this extremely racist country, leaves me no chance to proceed with this work and even communicate free on the issue with the international community, to say nothing of getting state assistance in this regard. No wonder that I have five times tried to get asylum abroad, in Europe and Canada, but failed, because supposedly of the activity of Russian and Israeli agents, in particular, and corruption of immigration services, in general.
