

## TENER – TO HAVE

1. The forms of tener are:
- |              |                     |
|--------------|---------------------|
| 1. yo tengo  | 4. nosotros tenemos |
| 2. tú tienes | 5. vosotros tenéis  |
| 3. él        | 6. ellos            |
| ella tiene   | ellas tienen        |
| Ud.          | Uds.                |

- I have a large backpack.  
Do you all (formal) have the books?  
We don't have the red folder.  
Does she have a blue car?
- Yo tengo una mochila grande.  
¿Tienen Uds. los libros?  
No tenemos la carpeta roja.  
¿Tiene ella un carro azul?

2. TENER QUE – Use a “que” after the forms of tener when you want to say “HAVE TO do something”.

- I have to read a book.  
We have to eat dinner.  
Do you all (informal) have to go?  
She doesn't have to work.
- Yo tengo que leer un libro.  
Tenemos que comer la cena.  
¿Tenéis vosotros que ir?  
Ella no tiene que trabajar.

3. TENER EXPRESSIONS – The following expressions are said with “tener”.

- tener hambre – to be hungry  
tener sed – to be thirsty  
tener \_\_ años – to be\_\_ years old  
¿Cuántos años tiene Ud.? - How old are you?

- tener mucha hambre – to be very hungry  
tener mucha sed – to be very thirsty  
tener frío – to be cold  
tener calor – to be hot

- I am hungry.  
She is very hungry.  
We are thirsty.  
Luis and Juan are very thirsty.  
Julia is 15 years old.

- Yo tengo hambre.  
Ella tiene mucha hambre.  
Tenemos sed.  
Juan y Luis tienen mucha sed.  
Julia tiene quince años.

#### **5. IR A – TO GO TO**

**Going is almost always followed by “TO a place” or going “TO do something.” This is why “ir” is almost always followed by “a”.**

**I am going to the store.**

**Voy a la tienda.**

**We are going to church.**

**Vamos a la iglesia.**

**You (fam) are going downtown.**

**Vas al centro.**

**She is going to read.**

**Ella va a leer.**

**You all (fam) are going to eat.**

**Vais a comer.**

**Are they going to understand?**

**¿Van a comprender ellos?**
