52. **Infinitives** - The most basic form of a verb. In English infinitives have the word “to ...” in front. In Spanish, they end in AR, ER, or IR. Use the infinitive of a verb after a conjugated verb (back to back) or after a preposition (de, para, a, después de, antes de). I.e. Necesito hablar. Me gusta estudiar. Para estudiar, necesito un libro.
53. **Making Sentences Negative** – Put “no” before verb. No me gusta, no hablamos, no comes. Use “no, no...” to answer a question negatively. No, no estudio español. Double negatives are allowed in Spanish – No me gusta nada la clase. No escribo ni la tarea ni el cuento.
