Dear Mr. Abbas,

RE: proposal vital for the PA

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, 76. I appeal to you for assistance on matters of paramount importance for the destiny of civilization, in general, for the proper solution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, in particular.

As many now incline to think, the one-state solution is the only proper solution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, because, in particular, it would lead society forward to a higher ideology consistent with the current tendency for globalization, unity and cooperation, while the two-state solution would push society backward to the wildness of primitive nationalism fraught with new most dangerous confrontations.

The one-state solution however needs the proper reform of ideology and society, which suggests the necessity for the reform of modern science and education. Indeed, civilization is experiencing now a GENERAL IDEOLOGICAL CRISIS manifesting itself in different ways, in the Israel-Palestinian conflict, in particular; underlying that crisis, as an analysis shows, is the CRISIS OF MODERN SCIENCE which therefore needs a radical reform. Fortunately, the way to such a reform has been paved by my independent research in exact sciences and, recently, in humanities.

The only world organization that could and must lead the reform of modern science is UNESCO. However UNESCO, as well as the major scientific centers and universities, seem to be thoroughly paralyzed by scientific establishment who resist any reform threatening their privileges. For that reason, I have launched my own website, The Reform Science Center, aimed at coordinating the reform of modern science. Clearly, such a mission cannot be hinged long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner, but needs support and participation of the whole scientific community, which is impossible to ensure on my own. At present, to proceed with the mission, I need a small office (for five or so persons) for THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER OF REFORM SCIENCE sponsored possibly by UNESCO.

In this connection, given your UNESCO membership, as well as your interest and resolution to find the proper solution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, would you please mobilize the power of your supporters to overcome the resistance of the European establishment and create, possibly in Europe, the above Reform Science Center, possibly under my direction and the UNESCO sponsorship, which would enable me to proceed with the mission and prepare younger researchers to take it over when necessary.
