	knit on side A, Purl on side B

same directions as for KTBL, used symbol to better define chart visually  
slip tbl as to purl, place back on working needle, ptbl

For my scarf I cast on 33 stitches using a size US 6.5 needles and Caron Simply Soft yarn

Using the recommended needle size for your yarn; cast on in multiples of 9+6,

After you cast on knit 1 row before starting chart.

you can end the chart on either row 11 or 24

When you are done knit 1 row and bind off

Gauge for size is not a factor, but I do suggest using the needle size listed on your ball band.

If you are a loose knitter you may want to go down a needle size. I think this works best when knit at a slightly tighter gauge due to the variety of stitches used.

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
