
2. Hotel

3. The City of Newport



Newport is a multi-cultural city with its own unique atmosphere, where traditional industries sit alongside new electronics and financial service sectors.

Standing at the gateway between England and Wales, Newport covers a geographical area of just over 73.5 square miles and is a vibrant, forward-thinking city steeped in a rich industrial heritage, dating from the nineteenth century when its important strategic location was first recognised.

Newport is surrounded by beautiful landscapes, including the For-

est of Dean, the UK's largest oak forest, the Wye Valley, designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the undulating Vale of Usk, famous for its salmon fishing. For breathtaking walks, or a leisurely drive, the Brecon Beacons National Park is less than an hour's drive away. Cyclists are also catered for, with superb mountain biking on offer at nearby Cwmcarn.

There are fantastic sporting facilities and events in Newport; the Wales National Velodrome; first-class rugby union within five minutes walk of the city centre at Rodney Parade; and the new Twenty Ten Course at The Celtic Manor, the first course ever to be built especially for The Ryder Cup. Golfers are spoilt for choice, with over thirty golf clubs in the area, eight of which are within ten minutes drive of the city centre. www.greensofsouthernwales.com

The area is steeped in heritage, ranging from Celtic and Roman, with the historic sites at Caerleon and Caerwent, to fascinating mediaeval castles at Chepstow, Caerphilly and Newport. Evidence of the more recent industrial heritage can be found at the Transporter Bridge, and at Fourteen Locks Canal Centre, and the Museum and Art Gallery houses fascinating displays depicting archaeology, art, natural sciences and local history. Tredegar House is the architectural wonder of Wales, a stunning Restoration mansion, and the ancestral home of the Morgan family.

4. Bowlplex, Cwmbran

4.1 Location

Located in the Leisure @ Cwmbran development which provides a focus for leisure and entertainment in Cwmbran.

Leisure @ Cwmbran is a 100,000 sq ft town centre mixed use leisure scheme development involving 8 screen cinema Vue Cinema, 20 lane bowling alley Bowlplex, 8,000 sq ft restaurant Frankie & Benny's, 10,000 sq ft children's crèche to Zoopadoopa, Peachy Keens, Saloon 7, Harvester, the Gravey Train and the nightclub Delilah's.



4.2 Facilities

As well as the 20 bowling lanes, the centre has a large screen for sporting event coverage, American style pool tables, an arcade, vending machines, fruit machines and the Bar & Grill where you can eat.

Parking is not available at the Bowling Centre. The Leisure @ Cwmbran facility has free 24 hour 365 days a year parking adjacent to the main leisure complex.





5. Fees and payments

5.1 Banquet Tickets

The cost of the tickets is Stg 20.

Anyone who has requested tickets needs to pay for them on or before August 19th.

5.2 Arrival Buffet- Thursday 23rd August

The cost of the meal is Stg. 10 for players & Stg. 15 for parents.

Anyone who has requested tickets needs to pay for them on or before August 19th.

6. Bowling Balls

6.1 Limit of 4 balls per player

Recent experience and results during Junior & Youth Tournaments (home and away) has shown that players are creating more problems for themselves by making excessive ball changes rather than addressing the issues when playing below par or making adjustments on difficult conditions

For this Triple Crown a decision has been made to restrict the number of bowling balls allowed per player to 4.

We would ask parents who are flying or driving **not** to bring additional balls as the players will not be allowed to exceed the 4 ball limit.

We will review the restriction going forward based on the Coaches reports and results.

7. Dress Code

7.1 Travelling

Teams travelling to and from the tournament must wear their official tracksuit.

Players getting new jackets must wear plain black trousers or plain black tracksuit bottoms, and a plain white T shirt or polo shirt.

7.2 Training Sessions

Players must wear a respectful 'polo shirt' for the training session.



8. Code of Conduct / Code of Behaviour

As you will be aware recent issues highlighted by Players, Parents, Coaches and Officials in relation to Club Practice sessions, the EYC in April 2012 and other local tournaments have resulted in a renewed focus and eradicating unacceptable behaviour from Junior bowling.

A specific session on Bullying was held with both the Children and Parents in ALSAA to reinforce the specifics in this area:

- Bullying is repeated verbal, physical, social or psychological behaviour that is harmful and involves the misuse of power by an individual or group towards one or more persons.
- Cyber bullying is commonly defined as the use of information and communication technologies to support repeated and deliberate hostile behaviour intended to harm others. It is sometimes used as an extension to other forms of bullying, and can result in the target of bullying experiencing social, psychological and academic difficulties.

The outcome has been that Players, Coaches and Officials must sign and be governed by the agreed Codes of Conduct / Codes of Behaviour.

8.1 Spectators and Parents

These Codes of Conduct / Codes of Behaviour have been extended to Parents and Spectators to demonstrate a positive re enforcement of the importance of this code to the players and also to ensure a clear understanding of the behaviour expected by parents and spectators at all times.



9. Travel


The teams will travel by coach and ferry to the tournament. There are 3 pick up points

- at The Wright Venue, Airside Swords, at 4:50am
- then on to Palmerstown, Palmerstown House, at 5:10am
- final pick up at the Basketball Arena in Tallaght at 5:30am.

Please pay attention to the pick up locations and times so there are no delays that could impact our journey onward.

From there we will travel to Rosslare, journey time a little over 2 hours, board the ferry and on to Pembroke, hoping to arrive around 1:00 pm. From there it will take a little over 2hrs to reach Newport.

9.1 Pick up point 1 - The Wright Venue, Airside Swords, at 4:50am




How to find The Wrights Venue

From Dublin Airport:

- Leaving the airport, turn to left (1st exit on the airport roundabout), following signs for Swords/Drogheda and Belfast.
- Go straight over (2nd exit) at the Cloghran roundabout.
- Continue along this road until you pass the Texaco garage on your left.
- You will see a sign for VHI here.
- At the next set of traffic lights, turn right into Airside Retail Park.
- Passing the front of Premier Inn, take the next road to the right and the car park is on the left, beside The Wright Venue (opposite Subway and VHI office).



9.2 Pick up point 2 – Palmerstown House, Palmerstown, at 5:10am





- Drive 0.6 km
- Turn left onto Kennelsfort Road Upper
- Drive 0.1 km
- Turn left onto Lucan Road
- Destination on the right.

9.3 Pick up point 3 – Basketball Arena in Tallaght at 5:30am.

From M50 Junction 7 (Lucan/ Palmerstown/ N4 exit)

- Head south on M50 towards junction 11 (Tallaght Rd/N81) [drive 8.7km]
- At junction 11, exit onto Tallaght Rd/N81 [drive 550m]
- At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit (right over M50) onto Tallaght Rd/N81 heading to Tallaght/Blessington [drive 850m]
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit (right) onto Tallaght Rd [drive 200m]
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit (left) and stay on Tallaght Rd [drive 240m]
- Turn right onto Castle Park [drive 550m]
- Continue onto Tymon Rd [drive 200m]
- Turn right onto Tymon Ln [drive 600m]
- Take the 1st right to stay on Tymon Ln [drive 57m]
