His personality is shown in His teaching, His searching, His knowledge and His works

John 14:17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

John 14:26 But the Counsellor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

John 15:26 "When the Counsellor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me.

He reproves, helps, glorifies, intercedes

John 16:7-13 But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counsellor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgement: in regard to sin, because men do not believe in me; in regard to righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and in regard to judgement, because the prince of this world now stands condemned. "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

Romans 8:26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express.

He executes the offices peculiar only to a person.

Luke 12:12 for the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say."

Acts 5:32 We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him."

Acts 15:28 It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements:

His divinity is established from the fact that the names of God are ascribed to him

Psalms 95:7 for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. Today, if you hear his voice,

"

Divine attributes are also ascribed to him, omnipresence

Psalms 139:7 Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?

Ephesians 2:17 He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near.

Ephesians 2:18 For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For we were all baptised by one Spirit into one body--whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free--and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

Creation is ascribed to him

Genesis 1:2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

Job 26:13 By his breath the skies became fair; his hand pierced the gliding serpent.

Psalms 104:30 When you send your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the earth.

and the working of miracles

Matthew 12:28 But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.
