
How to Make a Turkey Bean Bag

Materials:


- 1. 7 inch by 14 inch piece of brown felt or fabric. Thread to match.
- 2. 6 ribbons 12 inch in length
- 3. scraps of yellow felt and red felt for beak.
- 4. two google eyes
- 5. hot glue
- 6. paper for pattern
- 1. Make a pattern using the shape below. Each square represents 1 inch. Cut out the pattern.




2. Cut out two shapes from the brown fabric.



3. I sewed on the yellow beak and gobble to the **right side** of the fabric using a zigzag stich.



4. I wrapped the ribbons around my fingers and stitched them to the edges of the right side of fabric. The longer sections point inward so they will be inside when sewn.



5. Put the 2nd shape on top and stitch around the edge making sure the tops of the ribbons only get caught on one end. leave an opening at the bottom so a filler can be added. I stitched using a ¼ inch seam allowance. Clip by the neck so it will turn inside out cleanly.



- 6. Turn it inside out and it should look similar to this. I put some cotton filler in the head to puff it out a bit. Glue eyes on with hot glue.
- 7. Fill it with a bean bag filler such as beans, rice, sand, or small wood pellets. Sew the bottom shut.
