Dear James,

I'm afraid your letter & list got lost in all the mass of paper-work here, & only came to the surface recently when I went through a collection of neglected work.

Your work is probably all done & you don't need this - if my letter ever reaches you. I've looked through the list, but you probably know more than I do - some of this stuff I'd entirely forgotten! I can't think where you got hold of it all. The only thing I don't see (unless I missed it) is the very first adult publication of mine - a contribution to a symposium called 'Objections to Roman Catholicism', published (I think) in 1960 or 1959. I don't have a copy so I'm not sure. My

inhibition was acclaimed by reviewers, & it really
began my career as a writer for adults. The book was
one of a series in which believers criticized their own
religion or system. My essay was on Authority - the
Church (not an easy subject at that time!)

I hope this isn't too late or that
