

Ladies and Gentlemen,

RE: ME and other world problems

I am an independent researcher, an Israeli citizen. I apply to you concerning the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and its solution, in particular. It is quite natural that finding solution to this problem has become one of the main priorities of the European foreign policy. However, as an analysis shows, the two-state solution, which now dominates the minds of European and American politicians, as well as Palestinians, does not seem scientifically tenable and therefore is hardly achievable.

Indeed, whatever is the historical fact, the ethnic Jewish and Palestinian communities of Israel could, scientifically, have been upgraded to the status of separate states only if they had had recognizable geographical borders. As such borders are nonexistent, the two-state solution is a mirage, a likely pretext for a civil war. Therefore it is only the one-state solution that is possible; such a solution, when realized, would be based on higher ideology consistent with the present trend of globalization and would be beneficial for all spheres of society. To achieve the one-state solution, however, it would be necessary to reform modern society, modern science and education first of all. Such a reform, which may take several decades, would also be necessary to resolve all the other global problems, including the present crisis of the European Union itself, especially as the Union is sometimes considered the main obstacle to the progress of civilization.

As to the reform of modern science, fortunately, I have discovered the way to it, actually started it and developed the proper methodology for it; now, to proceed with that mission, I desperately need support from international community, the European Union, first of all.
