

# Leprechaun Toilet Paper Roll Puppet

Cut on the lines to make strips of faces. Each set should depict faces with 4 different emotions. Wrap the strip around a toilet paper roll on the top half and tape. Cut on the lines to make a strip that has the front and back of a Leprechaun. Cut out the circle where a face should appear. Roll the paper around the toilet paper roll slightly loose so the tube with the faces can be turned easily inside it. The faces should fit into the cut out area as you turn it. Read a Leprechaun story and have the students change the faces as the mood of the story changes.
