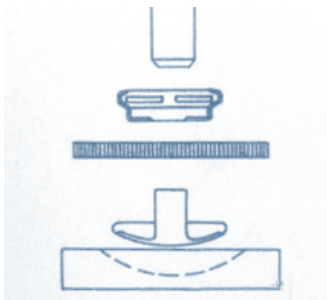

# SETTING PRESS STUDS

## *size*

The press stud post should stand around 1mm above leather for a good fixing.



## *type*

Line 20 ideally for 2.0-3.0mm leather  
Line 24 for 3.0-4.0mm leather

For leather below 2mm use Glove Snaps or Multi-Purpose Snaps (also known as Segma snaps or Line 16)

## *tools*

Each type comes with a specific setter that is required to get the correct fixing.

Use with the concave anvil to stop the top cap from flattening as you hit.

## *how*

Punch your hole for the press stud and place the correct two parts together either side of the leather. Use a stone or marble block.

Hit with 2 or 3 firm taps keeping the setter vertical. You can finish by rotating the setter as you give a final tap

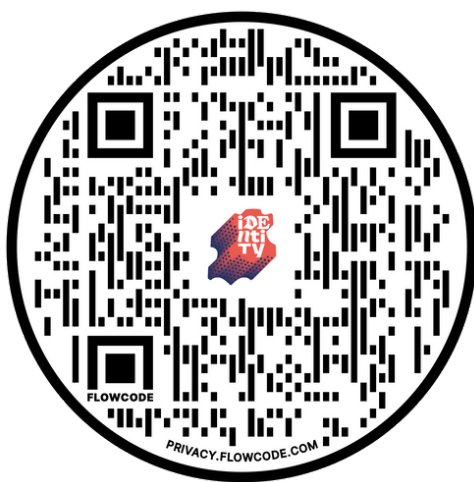
