

for people who make, mend or adapt things out of leather



Card case template

A great small project with simple line—works best with firm but thin leather around 1mm in substance—such as vegetable tanned kipside calf or finished chrome calf leather from the 3kg pieces bag, or for chunkier look use 1.4mm veg tan buffalo calf.

You will need: harness or stitching needles, waxed thread, a sharp knife or shears, and an awl. For even stitching use a rotary stitch wheel marker—all available from the website :www.identityleathercraft.com

**Tip**: for using up small pieces of leather the case can be made also by cutting along the bottom fold and allowing the stitching to run all the way round as indicated by the orange line
