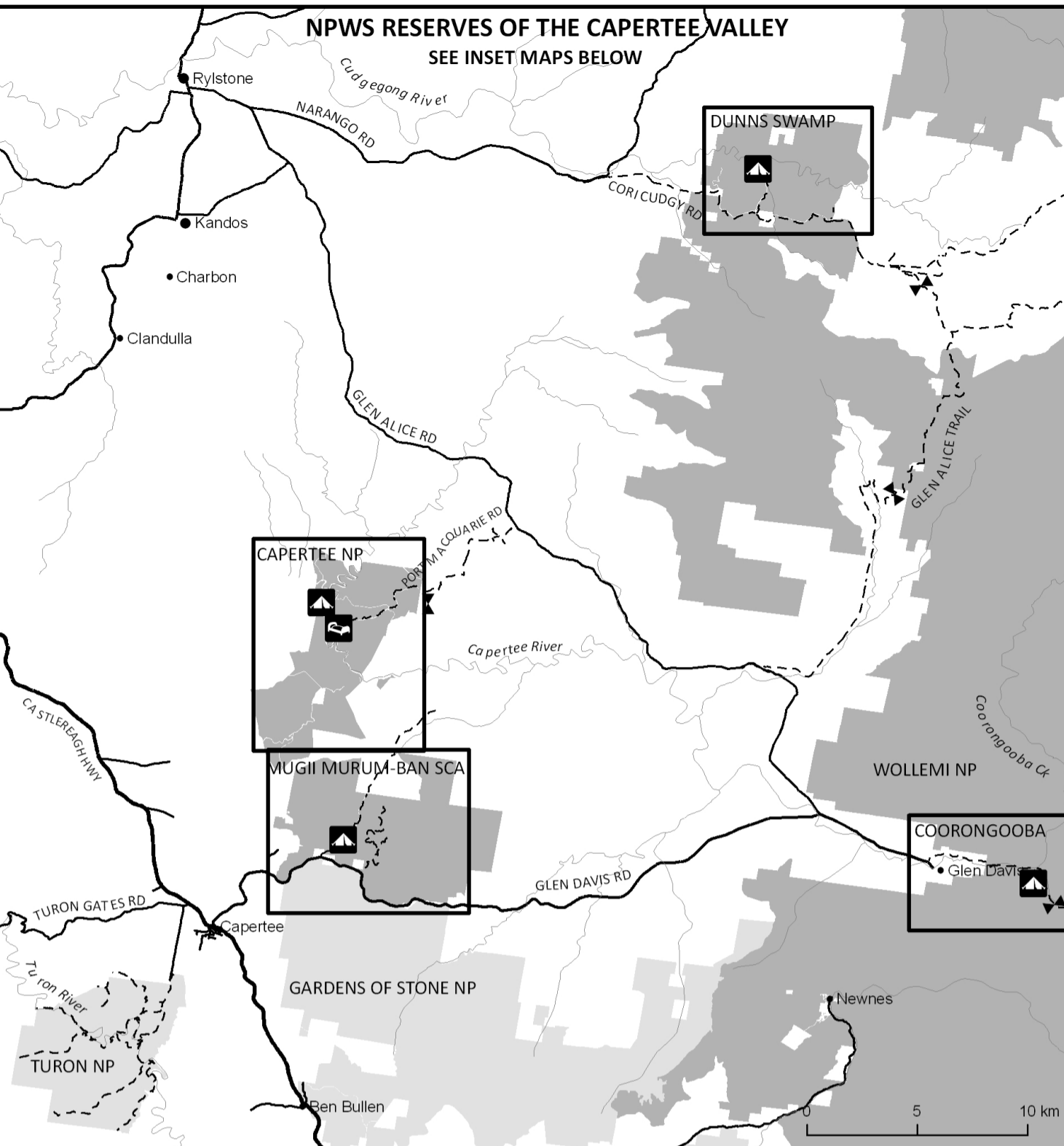


NPWS RESERVES OF THE CAPERTEE VALLEY

CAMPING AND ACCOMMODATION

Vehicle based camping is available at the following locations:

- **Dunns Swamp – Wollemi NP:** A beautiful camping area suitable for tents, camper trailers and caravans next to the Dunns Swamp area of the Cudgong River. Fishing, canoeing, birdwatching, bushwalking and swimming are popular activities. Access via Coricudgy Rd, Rylstone. Camping fees apply.
- **Coorongooaba – Wollemi NP:** A secluded camping area deep in the Capertee Valley surrounded by towering sandstone escarpments. The site is adjacent to the Capertee River and Coorongooaba Creek and activities include bushwalking, birdwatching, swimming and liloing. Access via Glen Davis Rd, 1km west of Glen Davis township.
- **Airly Camping Area – Mugii Murum-ban SCA:** Located in the Airly Gap valley this campsite provides access to exploring the Airly and Genowlan mesas. Birdwatching, bushwalking and mountain biking are popular as well as exploring nearby historical ruins and spectacular lookouts. Access via Airly Gap Trail off Glen Davis Rd, 5km east of Capertee.
- **Capertee Camping Area – Capertee NP:** Located on the Capertee River north of The Homestead, this campsite allows visitors to explore the park on foot or mountain bike. Birdwatching is very popular. Access via Port Macquarie Rd through locked gate at the park entry. Gate access code can be obtained from the Mudgee office on (02) 6370 9000.

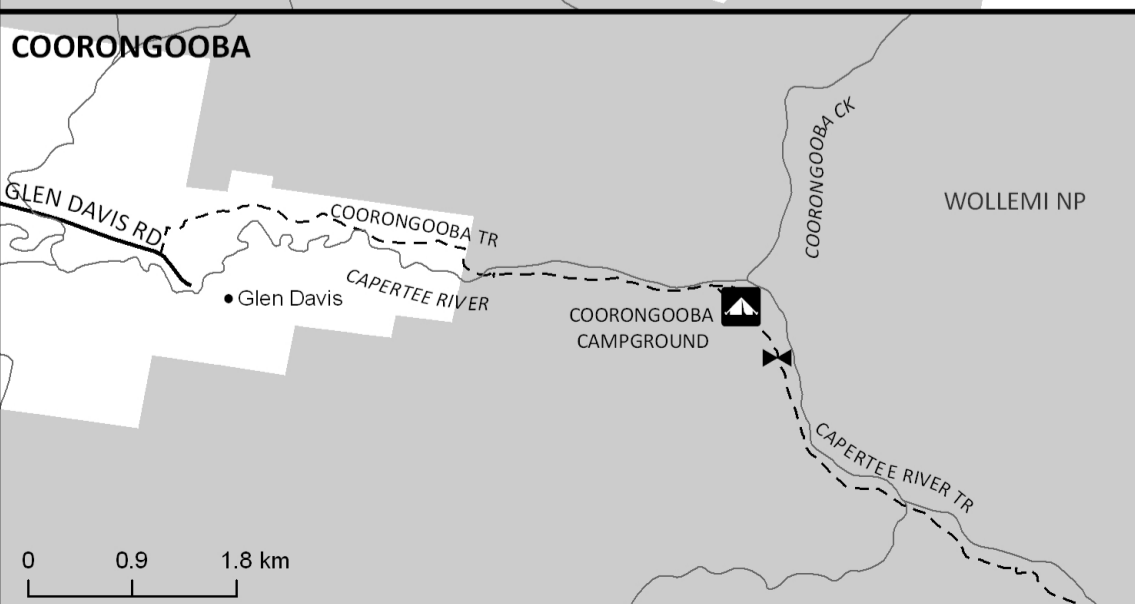
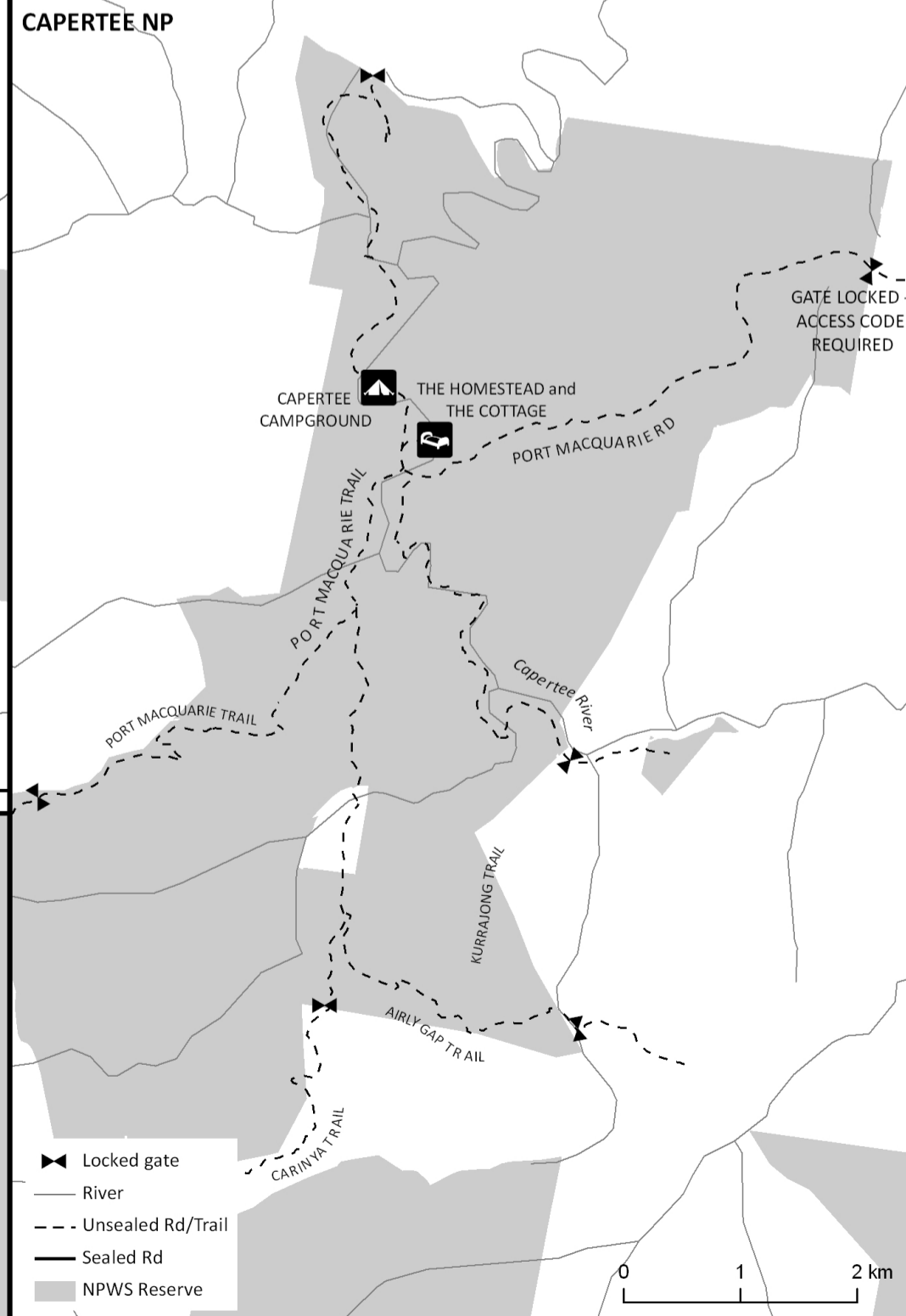
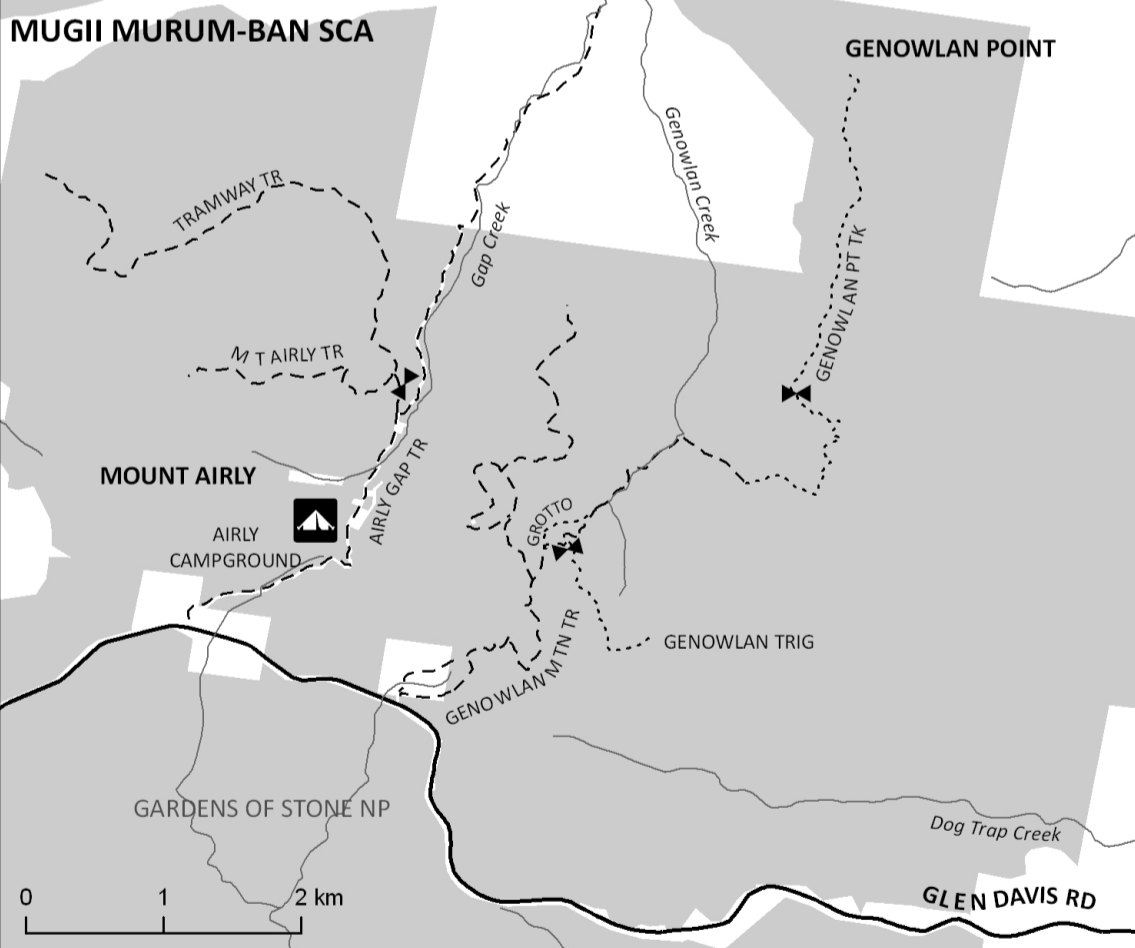
Accommodation is available in Capertee National Park:

- **The Homestead –** A four bedroom rural homestead with a wrap-around veranda in the picturesque Capertee River valley. Fully furnished with fireplace and BBQ. Sleeps 10.
- **The Cottage –** A small two bedroom cottage with basic furniture and a kitchenette. Sleeps 6.

Bookings essential and fees apply for the Homestead and the Cottage. Phone Mudgee office on (02) 6370 9000.

GROUP ACTIVITIES:

Organised group activities may be undertaken in all three reserves. Non-commercial groups of <40 people should complete an Activity Notification form to advise of the group's intentions. Groups of 40 or more, or those undertaking education or training must obtain an Activity Consent. Commercial operators must be licensed to operate in NSW National Parks.
