TO SOCIETIES OF PHILOSOPHICAL MARXISM

Dear Colleagues,

RE: project of vital importance

I apply to you with a project the proper realization of which is of vital importance for the destiny of Europe and civilization as a whole. The project is concerned with the reform of modern science and education necessary to overcome the present general ideological crisis of civilization, now at its crucial stage. As professional philosophers and connoisseurs of Marxist works, you seem to be the most appropriate team to take up this project rooted in dialectical philosophy. The background of the project is as follows.

As my analysis shows, the crisis of modern science, in social sciences in particular, is underlying *the present general ideological crisis of civilization* now threatening the very existence of humankind. To overcome that crisis it is necessary to reform modern science. It was therefore providential perhaps that, during my half-life-long independent research, I have initiated the reform of modern physics, not officially recognized yet, and, owing to its new scientific method, developed a methodology for the reform of modern science in general, including humanities. With that experience, I have recently managed to develop the frameworks for the sciences of *politics* and *economics*, the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before and most socially important. To proceed with the reform of science, two years ago I launched a website, *The Reform Science Center*; www.reformscience.org, which now needs development into a full-fledged international organization.

I propose that you set up an independent organization titled, for example, THE WORLD REFORM CENTRE, the main tasks of which would be as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers of science worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance and as examples;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to start creating the science of religion suitable for universities and high schools; social importance of such a reform could not be overestimated;
 - (3) holding an online ARCHIVE to keep research works and a BULLETIN for the state of research;
 - (4) persuading faculty of universities to start teaching new sciences;
- (5) organizing seminars, workshops and conferences to disseminate knowledge of new sciences and resolve uncertainties, if they occur in the process of research;
 - (6) applying to governmental, scientific and philanthropic organizations for support;
 - (7) raising a fund to run the Centre, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success;
 - (8) publishing success of the reform through social networks and media.

You could simply start the project with editing, developing, publishing and teaching my enclosed works. In time the Centre may grow into a large institution worth getting support from UNESCO and perhaps joining it.

IN THIS CONNECTION WOULD YOU PLEASE DISCUSS THIS PROJECT WITHIN YOUR SOCIETY AND POSSIBLY TAKE OVER THIS MISSION THOROUGHLY FROM ME, BECAUSE, IN MY CURRENT CONDITIONS, IT WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE TO START IMPLEMENTING THE ABOVE PROJECT. I AM LOOKING FORWARD TO YOUR RESPONSE.
