TO ACADEMIES, UNIVERSITIES AND SCIENTIFIC SOCIETIES

Dear Colleagues,

I apply to you with a project aimed at reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. The project is based on my half-life-long independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that yielded the following results, not recognized yet officially:

(1) the reform of modern theoretical physics;

(2) the discovery of the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;

(3) the development of a methodology for reforming modern science in general;

(4) the development of the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics.

In the course of the above research, it has become clear that, to overcome the present general ideological crisis of civilization now threatening the very existence of humankind, it is necessary to start reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. I have actually started such a reform and launched a dedicated website to proceed with the mission, but now I need international support. So the aim of my project is to get support for that mission. The implementation of the project would be especially important for Europe, a multinational continent most vulnerable for ideological discords.

So I propose you to establish a new scientific organization, possibly an NGO, called, for example, THE WORLD REFORM CENTER (WRC), with the following main functions:

(1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance and as examples; at present I expect great results in reforming biology and microbiology, in particular;

(2) attracting philosophers of religion to start creating the science of religion suitable for universities;

(3) holding an online ARCHIVE to keep research works and a BULLETIN for the state of research;

(4) raising a fund to run the Center, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success; there would certainly be an enthusiastic support from philanthropic and scientific organizations and private persons.

If invited, I could run the Center and prepare younger researchers to substitute me when necessary. Otherwise somebody else could do that using my instructions and consulting me if necessary. It would be possible to start the project simply with editing, developing, publishing and teaching my enclosed works. Please see more information on the matter enclosed. I am looking forward to your response.
