

HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT INSTRUCTION

The South Shore School District shall provide instructional opportunities for its students in human growth and development as part of the district's health education program in grades one through 12.

Annually, the Board shall provide the parent(s) or guardian of each student enrolled in the district with an outline of the human growth and development curriculum used in the health education program and information on how the parent or guardian may inspect the complete curriculum and instructional materials. The human growth and development curriculum and instructional materials shall be available upon request for inspection at any time.

No student shall be required to take courses or participate in units of the human growth and development curriculum if his/her parent(s) or guardian files a written objection to such offerings with the principal.

The human growth and development curriculum shall be evaluated at least every three years by an advisory committee per Wisconsin Statutes.
