

## **STUDENT SCHEDULES/CORRESPONDENCE COURSES/ ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT/INDEPENDENT STUDY**

Students will be required to take eight hours of class per day. This could include work-study, youth options, correspondence courses, study hall and/or independent study.

Students taking courses through Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College, University of Wisconsin-Extension or a university or college may receive credit toward graduation provided they have obtained administrative approval in advance of taking the course. A one semester course will receive one-half (1/2) high school credit.

The student shall pay costs associated with taking the course, however, shall be reimbursed for tuition costs upon satisfactory completion of the course when credit has been applied toward graduation, except in the case of approved Youth Options program participation.

Any student who wishes to take an off-campus course with credit earned toward advanced degrees may do so at his/her own expense as long as it does not interfere with attainment of graduation requirements.

The Board believes that independent study is a learning activity motivated largely by the learner's own aim to learn for personal satisfaction. It is a course of study, which provides the learner with an opportunity to undertake an in-depth study of a particular interest somewhat independent of the class or other group instructional practices.

Students may participate in independent study projects with the approval of the principal. Approval and credit arrangements shall be given on a case-by-case basis.
