

ADMINISTRATION GOALS

The administration of the South Shore School District is responsible for the direction, coordination and control of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals established by the Board. Administrators should demonstrate leadership and be able to resolve the inevitable problems and obstacles which will arise inside the school system and in its relations with the community.

The Board expects the administration to specialize in:

1. identifying strengths, weakness, opportunities, problems and needs;
2. the processes of decision-making and communication;
3. how to plan, organize, implement and evaluate; and
4. how to coordinate and guide the various centers of power within the school and the community so as to enable people to do things together that they might not be able to do separately.

The Board and the administration shall work together to set yearly administration goals.
