

POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

In an attempt to insure equitable and just treatment for all, suggestions for changes in, revisions of or additions to existing policies and regulations are welcomed from employees and students.

Those in administrative positions are responsible for informing personnel of existing policies and regulations and for seeing that they are implemented in the spirit intended. Continuous disregard for Board policy and administrative regulation may be interpreted as willful neglect of duty and may constitute grounds for dismissal. Any employee who feels he/she is subject to arbitrary and/or capricious regulations may institute a formal grievance procedure.
