

ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS (OTHER THAN OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS)

Students who are not residents of the South Shore School District may attend school in the district on a tuition basis with the approval of the Board. The Board shall make a written agreement with the student's parent(s) or guardian for the payment of tuition. Transportation of nonresident students is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian except as provided for children with exceptional educational needs.

Nonresident student tuition may be waived under the following conditions:

- a. Students, who have gained the twelfth grade status and are residents of the South Shore School District at the time of gaining such status, shall be permitted to complete the twelfth grade without payment of tuition, even though their parents are nonresidents.
- b. A student who is a resident and enrolled in the district at the beginning of the school year may be permitted to complete the school year in the district without payment of tuition even through the student is no longer a resident of the district.
- c. A student whose parent(s) or guardian demonstrates plans to become a resident of the district within a nine-week period of time may be enrolled in the district without payment of tuition.
- d. A foreign exchange program student may attend school in the district without payment of tuition.
- e. The Board reserves the right to deny enrollment of a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another school district.
- f. Any student who is a resident of the school district on either the third Friday in September or the second Friday in January and was enrolled in the District for at least 20 school days in the current school year may complete the school year with tuition waived;
- g. Any student who 1) was a resident of the school district on the second Friday in January of the previous school year; 2) was enrolled in the district continuously from the second Friday in January of the previous school year to the end of the previous school year; 3) moved out of the district after the first Monday in February of the previous school year; and 4) continues to be a resident of Wisconsin shall be permitted to attend school in the current year without payment of tuition.

Each case will receive individual consideration by the administration and Board.
