

## **STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES**

Students shall conduct themselves while on the bus in a manner consistent with established standards. Misbehavior of any kind will not be tolerated.

Bus rider rules shall be adopted by the Board and distributed to students and their parents/guardians at the beginning of each school year. Building principals should send out follow-up letters during the school year as the need arises.

When a student fails to conduct him/herself properly on the school bus, such misconduct shall be brought to the attention of the building principal. Where continuing or serious problems, exist, the student's bus riding privileges may be suspended. Established procedures shall be utilized in disciplining students regarding misconduct on school buses.
