

EMERGENCY PLANS

Advance planning for emergencies and disasters is essential to provide for the safety of students and staff should a threat to safety arise from fire or other causes. Advance planning also strengthens the morale of all concerned to know that preparedness plans exist and that students and staff have been trained in carrying them out. Therefore, the South Shore School District shall develop and maintain emergency plans in accordance with requirements of state law for dealing with fires, civil emergencies, natural disasters, and other emergencies.

Building principal(s) shall be responsible for informing students and staff of emergency plans.
