

## EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSINGS

The district administrator may close schools or dismiss them early in the event of hazardous weather or other emergencies. In making the decision to close schools, the district administrator shall consider many factors, including the following:

1. Failure of buses to serve all parts of the school district;
2. Inability to furnish adequate heat in the school building(s) to bring temperature of classrooms to a comfortable standard or
3. Blizzard conditions which include snow and high winds making it difficult to walk extended distances to and from school buildings.

The administration shall develop procedures for notifying students, staff and parents in case of emergency school closing.
