

BUILDING AND GROUNDS SECURITY

Buildings of the South Shore School District constitute one of the greatest investments of the school district, therefore, it is deemed in the best interest of the district to protect the investment adequately.

Security should mean not only maintenance of a secure (locked) building and protection from fire hazards and faulty equipment. Security should also extend to safe practice in the use of electrical, plumbing and heating equipment. The Board requires and encourages close cooperation with local fire and sheriff's departments and with insurance company inspectors.

Access to the building

An adequate key control system shall be established which will limit access to the building to authorized individuals and will safeguard against the potential of entrance to the building by keys in the hands of unauthorized persons. The administration shall develop procedures to limit access to the building outside of regular school hours to authorized individuals only.

Protective devices designed to be used as safeguards against illegal entry and vandalism may be installed or provided when deemed necessary by the Board.
