

HAIRPIN LACE AND TATTED ANGEL

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Materials: 1 shuttle, size 20 or 30 thread, metallic thread for halo, hairpin lace loom

With size 20 or 30 thread, make a section of hairpin lace (HPL) 1 inch wide and 14 loops on both sides.



Upper Body: Wind 1 shuttle CTM with ball

Wing: R1: 6 – 4 – 6 clr RW

Ch1: 10 +LJ (to 1st p of R1) 3 DNRW SLT

R2: 2 – 2 clr DNRW SLT

Ch2: 3 +LJ (to 2nd p of R1) 8 – 2 +LJ (to base of R1) RW SLT

Head: Ch3: 2 RW

R3: 2 + (to Ch2) 10 – 2 clr RW

Wing: Ch4: 2 DNRW SLT

R4: 6 – 4 – 6 clr RW

Ch5: 2+ (to R3) 8 +LJ (to 1st p of R4) 3 DNRW SLT

R5: 2 – 2 clr DNRW SLT

Ch6: 3 +LJ (to 2nd p of R4) 10 +LJ (to base of R4) RW

Ch7: 4. Cut threads, leaving a few inches to work with. Thread through all Hairpin Lace loops together on one side. Tie to base of first Ring, work in ends.

Skirt: Wind 1 shuttle CTM with ball

R: 3 – 2 + (to HPL loop) 1 + (to next HPL loop) 2 – 3 clr RW

[Ch: 4 – 4 RW

R: 3 + (to prev R) 2 + (to next HPL loop) 1 + (to next HPL loop) 2 – 3 clr RW] 6 times, ending with cut and tie.

Halo: Wind 1 shuttle CTM with ball/spool of metallic thread

Join thread to picot joining Wing and Head

Ch: 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 etc, repeat enough times to join to picot on other side of Head. The number of repeats will depend on the thickness of the thread. If desired, work as a split chain so that the thread ends will be positioned in the middle to form a hanging loop.
